Purpose

This item revises the treatment for certain classifications in NCCI's *Basic Manual for Workers Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance* for Texas (*Basic Manual* for Texas).

Background

The workers compensation classification system groups employers with similar operations by classification so that loss costs and rates may be calculated to reflect overall employee exposure to injury.

In an effort to streamline the classification approach in Texas, NCCI performed an analysis of Texas classifications to determine where alignment for Texas with the multistate classification approach is appropriate. NCCI plans to use a phased filing approach to eliminate specified Texas classifications and/or phraseologies and reassign to multistate classifications. The overall expansion of the classification code system in Texas will provide further classification uniformity both in Texas and from a multistate level perspective, to better align exposure to pricing within an individual class code.

This item identifies the following Texas classifications for reassignment to multistate classifications:

- 11 Texas United States Longshore and Harbor Workers' (USL&HW) Act related classifications, and
- 9 Texas industrial classifications.

Proposal

NCCI proposes to eliminate certain Texas classifications or phraseologies and establish the multistate classification approach in Texas:

Impact

Classification reassignment to a different multistate code

The employers moving into newly established Class Code 6834 are expected to transfer from Texas Class Code 6823. Code 6834 will take the loss cost and rating values of Texas Code 6823, and historical data from Texas Code 6823 will be reassigned to Code 6834. Rating values will be calculated according to the standard procedure. Individual employers who transfer from Texas Code 6823 to Code 6834 should see no change in premium.

Classification reassignment to same multistate code

For the remaining Texas classifications that will be eliminated and reassigned to the same multistate code, it is possible that some payroll may transfer between codes included in the Proposal. The amount of payroll transferred cannot be identified using current industry data sources. The impact to individual employers will depend on the amount of payroll (if any) that transfers from code to code, as well as their associated loss costs.

Negligible impact to overall statewide premium is expected as a result of these changes.

Hazard group reassignment

For an employer with exposure in Class Code 8726F that participates in a deductible program or has a loss limit under the Retrospective Rating Plan, the employer may see a small decrease in premium due to the hazard group change in Texas from Group F to Group E.

Premium impacts will vary for employers depending on the proportion of an employer's exposure in Code 8726F. Due to the countrywide pure premium federal classification (F-classification) methodology, the impact to the loss cost is expected to be negligible.
