




CY2023 Enforcement Case Status




CY2023 Cases Pending by Subject Type





Claims EDI R3.1- Implementation

Testing opened January 12

- All carriers must complete testing before July 26, 2023.
- Carriers that use an EDI Vendor are automatically approved when the vendor completes the test plan.
- Small carriers that opted to use web entry are not required to test.

Claims EDI R3.1 - Billing

- Billing for costs associated with Claim EDI 3.1:
 - Data collection agent (DCA) may recover start-up costs and ongoing costs.
 - o Carriers must provide billing contacts to the DCA.
 - o Initial bills must be paid by July 26, 2023.
 - Governmental entities are excluded.
