

Prescription Drug Cost Transparency Pharmacy Benefit Managers

This document contains aggregate data from 24 pharmacy benefit managers (PBMs) from the 2020 calendar year. The data was collected under House Bill 2536, passed by the 2019 Texas Legislative Session. The Texas Department of Insurance did not audit the data; instead, the agency is reporting the data as reported by the PBMs.

The following table shows the aggregated rebates, fees, price protection payments, and any other payments collected from pharmaceutical drug manufacturers as reported by PBMs that responded to the data call. One PBM provided only six months of their 2020 calendar year data. This PBM is included in the table, however the data provided by the PBM indicates that it is less than one percent of the market. One small PBM did not submit any data for calendar year 2020.
