In accordance with the [Texas Administrative Code, Title 37, Part 7, Chapter 215, Section 215.7](#), the board must consist of at least three members, one-third of which must be considered public members, as defined by [Texas Occupational Code, Section 1701.052](#).

The chief administrator of the TDI Fraud Unit and the designated training coordinator may serve as board members, but only in an ex-officio, non-voting capacity.

Terms: Members serve may serve three-year terms, at the pleasure of the chief administrator of the TDI Fraud Unit.
