Susan Rokes is an active volunteer mediator with the Dispute Resolution Center (DRC) of Harris County, serving since 2016, mediating a variety of cases in the Justice of Peace Courts as well as at the DRC, including family cases. Mediations have ranged from insurance disputes to dog bite conflicts and included breach of contract cases of all varieties. Susan received the Outstanding Achievement Award from the Houston Bar Association in 2018 for mediation with the Harris County Dispute Resolution Center.

Susan's career began in Medical Technology, specializing in Microbiology. During the latter years while working as a medical technologist, she attended the University of Houston Law Center, completing her J.D.
