The Texas Department of Insurance has prepared an informal working draft to update the Filings Made Easy rule. Proposed changes include:

- Implement changes required by SB 978 (2015), SB 1554 (2015), and HB 1298 (2017).
- Eliminate manual rule filings.
- Make using the System for Electronic Rate and Form Filing (SERFF) mandatory for all filings, except for certificates of property and casualty insurance.
- Add Section 5.9311 (Copyright, Public Inspection, and Confidential Filings) and Section 5.9312 (Personally Identifiable Information).
- Repeal Section 5.9322(b) and move that language to Section 5.9324 without any changes.
