Notice of Workers' Compensation Filing
National Council on Compensation Insurance *Item P-1417(A)*

Description:

- The National Council on Compensation Insurance (NCCI) filed *Item P-1417(A)*—*Terrorism Risk Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2019 Endorsements (Amended Effective Date)* on October 14, 2020.
- *Item P-1417*, which revised the Terrorism Risk Insurance Program Reauthorization Act Disclosure Endorsement, was approved for new and renewal policies that are effective on or after 12:01 a.m. on January 1, 2021.
- The only change proposed in *Item P-1417(A)* is to expand the applicability of this endorsement to apply to any in-force policy, in addition to new and renewal policies, in effect on or after January 1, 2021.
- Per Commissioner's Order No. 3142, the Commissioner may issue an order approving the filing, approving the filing with changes, or rejecting the filing.
