

Informal working draft and meeting notice on workers' compensation substitutes rule
Texas Administrative Code, Title 28, Chapter 5, Subchapter G, Division I, Section 5.6302

Comments due: May 14, 2018

The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) has posted an informal working draft rule relating to Insurance Code Section 541.051 (Misrepresentation Regarding Policy or Insurer) and Labor Code Section 406.052 (Effect of Other Insurance Coverage). The draft proposes narrowing the scope of the rule by clarifying which products require notices and updating the required protective disclosures for advertisements, applications, and policies or evidences of coverage for those products.

TDI will host a stakeholder meeting to discuss the draft from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., Central time, on May 11, 2018. [Meeting details.](#)

Pursuant to Chapter 2001 of the Texas Government Code, TDI's formal rule proposals must analyze the potential economic costs of compliance. However, often only industry is in a position to determine what costs will result from rules. In order to prepare its analysis, TDI requests that industry provide specific information regarding the costs of the provisions contained in the informal draft.
