NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**


The Commissioner of Insurance will hold a public hearing under Docket No. 2743 on October 30, 2012, at 9:30 a.m. in Room 100 at the William P. Hobby Jr. State Office Building, 333 Guadalupe St., Austin, Texas, to consider the Texas Windstorm Insurance Association's petition related to the maximum limits of liability for windstorm and hail insurance policies covering the following: residential dwellings and individually owned townhouses and associated contents; contents of apartments, condominiums, or townhouses; commercial structures and associated contents; and governmental structures and associated contents. The petition was submitted pursuant to Texas Insurance Code §§2210.502 - 2210.504.

The petition does not affect the Association's rates.

This notice is made pursuant to Texas Insurance Code §2210.504(a), which requires notice and a hearing prior to the commissioner's approval, disapproval, or modification of the Association's proposed adjustments to the limits of liability for its windstorm and hail insurance policies. Texas Insurance Code Chapter 40 does not apply to this proceeding.
