RE: Changes to Appointment Offer and Other Processes for Designated Doctor Exams and Report Filing for Designated Doctor and Required Medical Exams

Starting Monday, September 19, 2022, the Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) will automate several processes for designated doctors and their administrators through their TXCOMP profiles. The changes are:

- Offering appointments to designated doctors only through TXCOMP. This will replace the current system of DWC faxing appointment selection response sheets (ASRs) and returning them by fax.
- Accessing designated doctor exam orders and the corresponding DWC Form-032, *Request for Designated Doctor Examination*.
- Requesting more time to complete reports or requesting assistance with getting medical records.
- Updating information about rescheduled designated doctor exams.
- Entering data and filing required designated doctor and required medical exam (RME) reports.

This table shows important dates for designated doctor and RME process changes. In addition to the process changes listed below, **TXCOMP will be unavailable from 6 p.m. on Thursday, September 15, 2022, to 8 a.m. on Monday, September 19, 2022, to implement the system changes.**
