RE: Informal Posting: Revisions to DWC Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Forms 01, 02, and 03

The Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (TDI-DWC) is accepting comments on minor revisions to DWC EDI-01 – *EDI Trading Partner Profile*, DWC EDI-02 – *Insurance Carrier or Trading Partner Medical Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Profile*, and DWC EDI-03 – *Medical EDI Compliance Coordinator and Trading Partner Notification*. The revised forms are available at <http://www.tdi.texas.gov/wc/rules/drafts.html>. The revised forms were posted to the TDI-DWC website on September 1, 2016, and the comment period closes on September 15, 2016, at 5 p.m. Central time.

Revisions to DWC EDI forms 01, 02, and 03 update the public information note, TDI-DWC's contact information, and email address necessary for EDI claim and medical submissions. Further, revisions to DWC EDI-01 delete the medical contact information field because EDI forms 02 and 03 address medical submissions. Revisions to DWC EDI-01 also delete the trading partner's mailing address field and reference to transmission frequencies and payments because these fields are not necessary for EDI claim or healthcare plan matching submissions. The revisions retain the trading partner's physical address field, include global formatting changes and a FAQ section consistent with other TDI-DWC forms.

The revised forms are not formal rule proposals and comments received will not be treated as formal public comments for the purposes of the Administrative Procedure Act.
