General Description:

The Series 2000 Snap-Lock Aluminum roofing panel is a 0.032" thick Aluminum panel that has snap lock seams. The panel has an effective area of 18" in width. Each finished roof panel is 119-1/2" long and has a male vertical leg that is 1-5/8" high and a female vertical leg that is 1-3/4" high.

Limitations:

Roof Deck: The Series 2000 metal roof panels must be installed over a minimum of 15/32" thick plywood deck.

New Roof Deck Attachment: The roof deck must meet or exceed the uplift requirements of the IRC and the IBC, and the deck must be installed in a manner to resist lateral loads.

Design Wind Pressures: Design wind pressure limitations are specified in Table 1.

Roof Slope: The panels must not be installed on roofs with a roof slope less than 1/2:12.

Installation Over an Existing Roof Covering: Not permitted

Installation:

General: The roofing panels must be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's recommended installation instructions and this evaluation report.

Roof Framing Members: The roof framing members must be spaced a maximum of 24" on center.

Underlayment: A minimum of one layer of No. 30 (Type II) asphalt felt must be used. The underlayment used must comply with one or more of the following: ASTM D 226, ASTM D 4869, or ASTM D 1970. The underlayment must be installed with 6" side laps and 3" end laps. The underlayment must be applied with corrosion-resistant fasteners in accordance with the manufacturer's installation instructions. Fasteners must be applied along the overlaps not farther apart than 6" on center.

Anchorage to Roof Deck: The roof panels must be fastened to the deck in accordance with Table 1. The roof panels are be secured to the roof deck with 18-gauge formed steel clips, measuring 3-1/2" long x 1-3/4" high. The clips are located 4" from each end and spaced as specified in Table 1. The clips are secured to the deck with two (2) No. 10 x 1" pancake head screws. The fasteners must be long enough to penetrate completely through the roof deck. The standing seams interlock with each other in a snap-lock seam.

Trims, closures, and accessories: Components, such as eave trim, rake trim, ridge trim, hip trim, and valley trim must be installed as required by Englert Metal Roofing Installation Manual.

Note: Keep the manufacturer's installation instructions available on the job site during the installation. Use corrosion resistant fasteners as specified in the IRC and the IBC.
