Installation: The wall framing shall be minimum Spruce-Pine-Fir dimension lumber. The window is secured to the wall framing using the integral nailing fin of the window with minimum No. 8 screws. The fasteners shall be spaced approximately 1 inch from each corner and approximately 6 inches on center along the perimeter of the window. All fasteners shall be long enough to penetrate a minimum of $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches into the wall framing members.
