Acceptance of Smaller Assemblies: Window assemblies with dimensions equal to or smaller than those specified are acceptable with the limitations specified in this report.

Installation:

System 1: Fasten the window to minimum Southern Yellow Pine dimension lumber using the integral nailing fin at the head, sill, and side jambs of the window frame. Secure the nailing fin to the wall framing with minimum No. 8 PPH screws. Locate the fasteners approximately 3" from each corner and approximately 4" on center. In addition, installation clips (galvanized steel, 20-gauge, 5"-8" long x 1-1/2" wide) are required. The installation clips are secured to the window frame with three No. 6 x 5/8" PFH screws and are secured to the wall framing with two No. 8 PPH screws. Locate one clip at the meeting rail locations of each side jamb. For two-wide units,

installation clips are required approximately 3" on each side of the mull at the head and the sill. Use fasteners long enough to penetrate a minimum of 1-1/2" into the wall framing. The nailing fin is silicone sealed to the window frame.

System 2: Fasten the window to minimum Southern Yellow Pine dimension lumber using the integral nailing fin at the head, sill, and side jambs of the window frame. Secure the nailing fin to the wall framing with minimum No. 8 PPH screws. Locate the fasteners approximately 3" from each corner and approximately 6"-8" on center. For two-wide units, installation clips (galvanized steel, 20-gauge, 5"-8" long x 1-1/2" wide) are required approximately 3" on each side of the mull at the head and the sill. The installation clips are secured to the window frame with three (3) No. 6 x 5/8" PFH screws and are secured to the wall framing with two (2) No. 8 PPH screws. Use fasteners long enough to penetrate a minimum of 1-1/2" into the wall framing. The nailing fin is silicone sealed to the window frame

Note: Keep the manufacturer's installation instructions available on the job site during installation. Use corrosion resistant fasteners as specified in the IRC and the IBC.
