Please read these instructions carefully

- Please type the information in the survey form. Do not change any of the column or row headings. Do not add footnotes or other information to the forms. If you fax your forms, please type your responses.
- Direct any questions to Richard Lee at 512-463-6534.
- On the Medicare Supplement Survey – Summary Information Form, indicate which plans you offer by marking an “X” under the appropriate column heading. Include only policies that are approved for sale in Texas on August 1, 2001. Include your name and contact information (e-mail address and telephone number) on the Summary form. By submitting the survey you are certifying that the information contained in the survey is true and correct.
- The information on rates refers to plans that have been marketed for the previous 12 months or have been recently approved and are currently available for sale in Texas. Use rates that were in effect on August 1, 2001.
- If you wish, you may view the current rate guide on our Web site at <http://www.consumer/ratesa.html>. This web address will take you directly to Plan A in the rate tables. Review the information for your company in each of the rate tables. If your rates for a particular plan have not changed from those listed on our Web site, please place an “X” in the “No Change” column on the survey form.
- If your rates have changed or you need to make corrections to the previously published rates, please do so on the survey forms.
- For group plans, please provide rates for group association plans only. DO NOT include employer group plans.
