General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Timothy Lee Claypool (Respondent) because he engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices and failed to notify TDI of an administrative action taken against him by the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (FINRA). Respondent did not appear at the hearing on the merits. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Appear at Hearing on the Merits

1. On June 26, 2024, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, together with a previously filed Original Petition, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings, and which attached documents were admitted as Exhibit 1 at the hearing on the merits.
2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

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3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition together to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Amarillo, Texas 79119-6228. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail to Respondent's designated email address.
4. After being properly served the notice of the date, time and location of the hearing on the merits, Respondent failed to appear for the hearing on September 4, 2024, as shown in the record in SOAH Docket No. 454-24-20459.

Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.051, and 4054.051; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing under TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing and failure to appear in person or by legal representative at the hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.





The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) seeks to take disciplinary action against you. This Notice of Hearing and the Original Petition, which is attached and incorporated for all purposes, states the allegations against you and the relief sought by TDI.

A public hearing will be held before an Administrative Law Judge on **Wednesday, September 4, 2024, at 9:30 a.m.** The hearing will take place via videoconference using a videoconference platform controlled by the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH), unless otherwise ordered to proceed in another manner by the Administrative Law Judge. The attached SOAH scheduling order includes the hyperlink and telephone contact information to attend the videoconference hearing.

The hearing shall be conducted under TEX. GOV'T CODE, ch. 2001 and 1 TEX. ADMIN. CODE, ch. 155. Unless otherwise directed by the Administrative Law Judge, the hearing shall continue from day to day in the offices of the State Office of Administrative Hearings until concluded. You have the right to appear at this hearing and to be represented by an attorney.

Parties that are not represented by an attorney may obtain information regarding contested case hearings on the public website of the State Office of Administrative Hearings at www.soah.texas.gov, or in printed format upon request to SOAH.



ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Timothy Lee Claypool. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.051, and 4054.051; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

1. Timothy Lee Claypool (Claypool), individual identification number 255513, holds a general lines agent license with a life, accident, health, and HMO issued by TDI on March 27, 2002. TDI also issued Claypool a property and casualty qualification on December 20, 2013.
2. On May 23, 2023, in matter number 2021073166102, the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (FINRA) sent a notice of suspension to Claypool informing him that effective June 16, 2023, pursuant to FINRA Rule 9552, Claypool would be suspended from associating with any FINRA member in any capacity because he failed to provide information to FINRA, which had been requested in accordance

with and pursuant to FINRA Rule 8210.¹ This notice gave Claypool the option to avoid suspension through compliance with FINRA rules by the suspension date.

3. Additionally, the May 23, 2023, FINRA notice stated that if Claypool failed to request termination of the suspension within three months of the date of this Notice of Suspension, he would automatically be barred from associating with any FINRA member in any capacity effective August 28, 2023.
4. On June 16, 2023, FINRA notified Claypool that the suspension had taken effect. This notice instructed him how to file a written request for termination of the suspension on grounds of full compliance with the Notice of Suspension.
5. On or about August 28, 2023, in Matter No. 2021073166102, FINRA barred Claypool from association with any FINRA member pursuant to FINRA Rule 9552(h) because Claypool failed to request termination of the suspension and failed to request a hearing to contest the suspension.
6. Claypool failed to notify TDI of this administrative action taken against him by a financial regulator of the United States.

Legal Allegations

1. Claypool has committed acts for which a license holder may be disciplined under TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101 because he engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).
2. Claypool failed to notify TDI of an administrative action taken against him by FINRA, a financial regulator of the United States, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4001.252(a)(3)


¹ FINRA was investigating Claypool after receipt of a referral from Northwestern Mutual Investment Services, LLC. FINRA sought information from Claypool about alleged unsuitable sales activity, trades, and investment referrals.

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, TDI asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the commissioner of insurance issue an order:

1. revoking Timothy Lee Claypool's license; and
2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.

ORDER NO. 2 AMENDED INITIAL ORDER¹

1. **Case Referred.** This case has been docketed at the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) and assigned to the undersigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). 2. **Hearing.** A hearing will be held at **9:30 AM (CT) on September 4, 2024**, remotely via Zoom videoconference. 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.405(c). The audio portion of the hearing will be recorded, and it will be the official record of the proceeding. Attend the hearing in one of these ways:

3. **Notice.** Staff for the Texas Department of Insurance must issue a notice of hearing. Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-.052.
4. **Before the Hearing: Exhibit List, Witness List, and Witness Preparation.** SOAH's Chief Administrative Law Judge has issued a General Order Relating to Submission of Exhibits For General Docket Hearings (<https://www.soah.texas.gov/general-order-relating-submission-exhibits>). A failure to comply with the requirements below may result in exclusion of the associated evidence of testimony:
 - a. **Seven (7) days before the hearing**, the parties will receive an email from SOAH's Secure File Transfers (noreply@moveitcloud.com) with a link to access the secure MOVEit platform.
 - b. **At least three (3) days before the hearing date**, submit a witness list and all exhibits and evidence to be offered at the hearing electronically using MOVEit.
 - c. **Exhibits:**
 - Make an exhibit list;
 - Number each exhibit sequentially; and
 - Paginate or bates stamp multipage documents.

- d. **Witness List:**
- Identify each witness you will call to testify;
 - Mention what each witness will testify about; and
 - Estimate how long each witness will testify.
- e. **Witness Preparation.** Before the hearing, the parties must:
- Give each witness the information above to access the hearing;
 - Give each witness all documents needed to participate in the hearing;
 - Have each witness's contact information available so additional documents can be provided to each witness during the hearing if needed.
5. **Prior to the hearing,** the parties shall confer to make sure each party received the other party's exhibits and witness lists.
6. **After the Hearing, File Admitted Exhibits.** *No later than the first business day following conclusion of the hearing,* the parties shall eFile only the exhibits that were admitted as evidence or accompanied by an offer of proof. 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.101(b)(1)(G)(iii). At the conclusion of the hearing, the ALJ will confirm on the record the admitted exhibits that are required to be filed. The ALJ may answer any procedural questions regarding this requirement.
7. **eFile.** Except as otherwise permitted by the SOAH Rules of Procedure, attorneys, state agencies, and other governmental entities are required to file pleadings electronically through eFileTexas.gov and an electronic filing service provider certified by the Texas Office of Court Administration. *See* 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.101.
8. **If you are Self-Represented.**
- a. **A Guide.** Some contested-case parties choose to represent themselves in the contested-case process. Self-represented litigants must follow SOAH's procedures, but SOAH has published material that will help

- b. **Filings.** If you are not represented by an attorney and you do not wish to file documents electronically, you may continue to file documents by fax; by mail addressed to SOAH, P.O. Box 13025, Austin, Texas 78711-3025; or by hand delivery to the appropriate SOAH office. All filings must contain the SOAH docket number and the names of the parties. For documents filed by mail, fax, or hand-delivery, the time of filing shall be determined by the SOAH file stamp.
 - c. **Electronic Service of SOAH orders.** SOAH is now offering you the ability to receive service of orders and other documents issued by SOAH through email rather than mail or fax. 
