General Remarks and Official Action Taken:

The subject of this default order is whether a general lines agent license with a life, accident, health, and HMO qualification should be issued to Pierre Da'Mond Hall (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Allegations mailed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted.

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Allegations

1. On January 7, 2025, the department sent a Notice of Allegations, attached as Exhibit A, to Respondent.
2. The department sent the Notice of Allegations to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, [REDACTED], Longview, Texas 75602. The department also sent the Notice of Allegations to one additional address, [REDACTED], Kilgore, Texas 75662.
3. Respondent received and waived an opportunity for a hearing because Respondent failed to send the department a written response to the Notice of Allegations within 20 days after the date the Notice of Allegations was mailed.

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Commissioner's Order

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4. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, and 4054.051; TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502¹; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051-2001.178.
2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
3. The department provided proper notice to Respondent under TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1), 2001.051, 2001.052, 2001.054, and 2001.056(4), and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.47, and 19.906.
4. Based on Respondent's failure to send the department a written response to the Notice of Allegations, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
5. Respondent failed to show compliance with the law.
6. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.

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

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
Order



I have reviewed TDI's records concerning Pierre Da'Mond Hall. I have confirmed that:





YOUR WRITTEN RESPONSE IS REQUIRED WITHIN 20 DAYS


YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO A HEARING AND ARE INVITED TO SHOW COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW. To request a hearing, you must send a written response to TDI within 20 days of the date this Notice was mailed.

If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, *you waive your right to a hearing*, and TDI may seek disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47, TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055, and TEX. GOV'T. CODE § 2001.056.

If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, without further notice to you, the commissioner of insurance may issue a default order that admits the factual matters asserted, deems all allegations as true, and orders the relief recommended in this Notice.

Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051; TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021–53.023; 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502;¹ and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051–2001.178.

Factual Allegations

License Application

1. On April 18, 2022, Pierre Da'Mond Hall (Hall) applied for a general lines agent license with a life, accident, health, and HMO qualification to be issued by the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI).
2. On June 6, 2022, TDI proposed to deny Hall's application based on his criminal history. Hall appealed that decision and made a written request for a hearing.

Criminal History

3. On February 27, 2006, Hall was convicted of misdemeanor possession of marijuana less than two ounces in cause no. 2005-2274 in the County Court at Law #1 in Gregg County, Texas. The court sentenced Hall to 180 days in jail, probated for one year, and ordered him to pay a fine.
4. On September 5, 2008, Hall was convicted of misdemeanor unlawful restraint in case no. 2008-2833, in the County Court at Law #1 in Gregg County, Texas. The court ordered Hall to pay a fine.
5. On November 5, 2013, Hall was placed on deferred adjudication for 2nd degree felony Burglary of a Habitation in cause no. 43033-B, in the 124th District Court of Gregg County, Texas. The court sentenced Hall to 5 years of probation and ordered him to pay \$1,500 in restitution to the victim.

6. On August 4, 2015, Hall was convicted of misdemeanor Possession of Marijuana Less than ounces in cause no. 2015-0660, in the County Court at Law #1 in Gregg County, Texas. The court sentenced Hall to 90 days in jail.
7. On June 14, 2018, the court extended Hall's probation for the 2nd degree felony burglary in cause no. 43033-B for two additional years and ordered him to complete 240 hours of community service.
8. On June 19, 2018, Hall was convicted of misdemeanor Obstruct Highway Passage in cause no. 2018-0494, in the County Court at Law #1 in Gregg County, Texas. The court sentenced Hall to 120 days in jail.
9. Hall's probation for the 2nd degree felony burglary in cause no. 43033-B was terminated on March 4, 2021, less than one year before he applied to TDI for an insurance license.

Legal Allegations

1. Hall has committed an act for which a license may be denied pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b) because he engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).
2. Hall committed felony or misdemeanor offenses and has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation, as contemplated in 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.502(d) and (f).
3. Hall committed an offense that TDI considers to be of such serious nature that it is of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure or authorization, as contemplated by 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e) and TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023.
4. Hall committed an offense for which fraud, dishonesty, or deceit is an essential element, as contemplated by 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(1).
5. Hall committed an offense with the essential elements of a burglary offense, as contemplated by 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(4)(E).
6. Pursuant to TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.021(d), the commissioner may deny Hall's application and consider him to have been convicted of the felony burglary of a

habitation in cause no. 43033-B in the 124th District Court of Gregg County, Texas, because:

- a. he completed the period of his supervision less than five years before the date he applied for the license, pursuant to TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.021(d)(1)(B)(i); and
- b. TDI determined:
 - i. Hall poses a continued threat to public safety; or
 - ii. employment of Hall in the licensed occupation will create a situation in which he has the opportunity to repeat the prohibited conduct.

- 7. TDI guidelines, 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that TDI:
 - a. considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
 - b. may refuse to issue an original license if TDI determines that the applicant has committed an offense that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation;
 - c. considers any offense for which fraud, dishonesty, or deceit is an essential element to be of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure, pursuant to 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(1); and
 - d. considers any burglary offense to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure, pursuant to 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(4)(E).

Relief Sought

TDI seeks the following relief:

- 1. denial of your license application; and
- 2. imposition of any other just and appropriate relief to which TDI may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.






