**General Remarks and Official Action Taken:**

The subject of this default order is whether an adjuster property and casualty license should be issued to Shaun Daniel Green (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Allegations mailed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted.

**Findings of Fact**

Failure to Respond to Notice of Allegations

1. On January 8, 2025, the department sent a Notice of Allegations, attached as Exhibit A, to Respondent.
2. The department sent the Notice of Allegations to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, [REDACTED], Jasper, Texas 75951.
3. Respondent received and waived an opportunity for a hearing because Respondent failed to send the department a written response to the Notice of Allegations within 20 days after the date the Notice of Allegations was mailed.

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
4. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

## Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, 4101.051, and 4101.102; TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051-2001.178.
2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
3. The department provided proper notice to Respondent under TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1), 2001.051, 2001.052, 2001.054, and 2001.056(4), and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.47.
4. Based on Respondent's failure to send the department a written response to the Notice of Allegations, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
5. Respondent failed to show compliance with the law.
6. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.

## Order

It is ordered that Shaun Daniel Green's application is denied. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.





If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, without further notice to you, the commissioner of insurance may issue a default order that admits the factual matters asserted, deems all allegations as true, and orders the relief recommended in this Notice.

## Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4101.051, TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021–53.023, 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502,<sup>1</sup> and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051–2001.178.

## Factual Allegations

### License Application

1. On June 23, 2022, Shaun Daniel Green (Green), individual identification no. 2575562, submitted an application to TDI for an adjuster all lines license.
2. On June 26, 2022, TDI proposed to deny Green's license application based on his criminal history. Green appealed that decision and made a written request for a hearing.

### Criminal History

3. On December 20, 2008, Green committed the offense of Aggravated Assault, a second-degree felony, by intentionally and knowingly threatening imminent bodily injury to the victim with the use of a deadly weapon, a firearm. On April 27, 2009, Green was sentenced to seven years of deferred adjudication in Case No. 09-05474 in the 252nd District Court of Jefferson County, Texas. The court ordered him to pay a fine of \$1,500, restitution of \$200, and supervision fees, attorneys fees, and other court costs. Green's deferred adjudication was subsequently revoked on September 14, 2011, following his plea of true to committing the offenses of assault causes bodily injury family violence, interfering with an emergency call, and evading arrest, he was adjudicated guilty of felony Aggravated Assault.
4. On November 1, 2010, Green committed the misdemeanor offense of Criminal Mischief when he intentionally and knowingly tampered with tangible property, an electric meter, without the effective consent of the owners of the property, causing pecuniary loss to the owners. On August 24, 2011, Green pleaded guilty to Criminal Mischief in Cause Number 11-266226 in the County Court at Law No. 5 in

Montgomery County, Texas. On August 24, 2011, the court sentenced him to 20 days of confinement, restitution to the energy company victim, and other court costs.

5. On January 9, 2012, Green was found guilty of the second-degree felony offense of Aggravated Assault for intentionally and knowingly threatening imminent and bodily injury to a victim with a firearm and was sentenced to twenty years confinement in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ).
6. Green was released from prison on April 6, 2022, and is on parole until September 24, 2031.

## Legal Allegations

1. Green committed acts for which a license may be denied pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.102.
2. Green willfully violated an insurance law of this state, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(1).
3. Green engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).
4. Green has been convicted of a felony, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(8).
5. TDI guidelines and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that TDI:
  - a. considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
  - b. may refuse to issue an original license if the department determines that the applicant has committed a felony or has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation;
  - c. considers any offense for which fraud, dishonesty, or deceit is an essential element, to be of such serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure, 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(1);

- d. considers any felony involving moral turpitude or breach of fiduciary duty, to be of such serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure, 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(3); and
- e. considers the offense of Aggravated Assault to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure, 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.502(e)(3), and 1.502(e)(4)(B).

**Relief Sought**

TDI seeks the following relief:

- 1. denial of your license application; and
- 2. imposition of any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.



