General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether a general lines agent license should be issued to Jamon Crawford (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Allegations mailed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Allegations

1. On May 27, 2025, the department sent a Notice of Allegations, attached as Exhibit A, to Respondent.
2. The department sent the Notice of Allegations to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, [REDACTED], Carrollton, Texas 75007 and his last known email address.
3. Respondent received and waived an opportunity for a hearing because Respondent failed to send the department a written response to the Notice of Allegations within 20 days after the date the Notice of Allegations was mailed.

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4. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, and 4054.051; TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051-2001.178.
2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
3. The department provided proper notice to Respondent under TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1), 2001.051, 2001.052, 2001.054, and 2001.056(4), and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.47, and 19.906.
4. Based on Respondent's failure to send the department a written response to the Notice of Allegations, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
5. Respondent failed to show compliance with the law.
6. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.

Order

It is ordered that Jamon Crawford's application is denied. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.





NOTICE OF ALLEGATIONS AGAINST JAMON CRAWFORD**

The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) seeks to deny your application. This Notice states the allegations against you and the relief sought by TDI.

YOUR WRITTEN RESPONSE IS REQUIRED WITHIN 20 DAYS

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO A HEARING AND ARE INVITED TO SHOW COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW. To request a hearing, you must send a written response to TDI within 20 days of the date this Notice was mailed.

If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, *you waive your right to a hearing*, and TDI may seek disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47, TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055, and TEX. GOV'T. CODE § 2001.056.

If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, without further notice to you, the commissioner of insurance may issue a default order that admits the factual matters asserted, deems all allegations as true, and orders the relief recommended in this Notice.

Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051, and TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021–53.023, 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502, and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051–2001.178.

Factual Allegations

1. On November 29, 2023, Jamon Crawford (Crawford), individual identification number 2853387, submitted an application to the department for a general lines agent license with a life, accident, and health qualification.
2. The department proposed to deny Crawford's application on April 5, 2024, based on his criminal history. Crawford appealed the decision and made a written request for a hearing.

Criminal History

3. On October 18, 2006, Crawford was arrested for misdemeanor Evading Arrest and pleaded nolo contendere on March 27, 2007, in Cause No. CR-2006-09828-D, in the 4th Criminal Court of Denton County, Texas. Crawford was sentenced to deferred adjudication and 15 months of community supervision.
4. On July 5, 2007, Crawford drug his common-law spouse across the ground, threw her on the bed, choked her until she almost passed out, and then denied her the ability to phone 911. He was subsequently arrested for Felony Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, and three class A misdemeanors: Unlawful Restraint, Resisting Arrest/Search or Transport, and Interfering with Emergency Request for Assistance.
5. On September 14, 2007, Crawford pleaded guilty to 2nd degree felony Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon in Cause No. F-0712675 in the 291st District Court, Dallas County, Texas, and was placed on deferred adjudication for five years.
6. On April 2, 2008, Crawford was arrested for class A misdemeanor Evading Arrest, Unlawful Carrying of a Weapon, and Assault Causing Bodily Injury to a Family Member. Both the Evading Arrest and Unlawful Carrying of a Weapon charges were unadjudicated.

7. On May 16, 2008, Crawford pleaded nolo Contendere to Assault-Family Violence in Cause No. CR-2008-00332-A, in the County Criminal Court No. 1, Denton County, Texas. Crawford was sentenced to 99 days in the Denton County Jail.
8. On September 27, 2012, at approximately 4:28am, Trooper Hampton was dispatched to a one-vehicle rollover. When Trooper Hampton arrived, both Crawford and his passenger, T.A., were enroute to the hospital. Trooper Hamilton discovered a strong odor of alcohol emanating from the car during his investigation.
9. Trooper Hampton arrived at the hospital and informed Crawford he was under arrest and that a blood sample was needed. The hospital had previously run blood work for Crawford, and it revealed a blood alcohol content of .205.
10. Crawford remained at the hospital to continue medical treatment, and his passenger T.A. also remained at the hospital due to serious bodily injuries she suffered as a result of the crash.
11. On April 27, 2015, Crawford pleaded guilty to Intoxicated Assault with a Vehicle-Serious Bodily Injury, in Cause No. F-1249244-M, in the 194th District Court, Dallas County, Texas. Crawford was sentenced to eight years in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice-Institutional Division.
12. In March of 2020, Crawford was paroled in Cause No. F-1249244-M, and he was subsequently discharged from parole on April 1, 2023.
13. 59 days later, on May 28, 2023, Crawford was observed travelling approximately 110mph in a 70mph zone by Officer Tittle of the Carrollton Police Department. Officer Tittle activated his emergency lights to initiate a traffic stop, but Crawford continued to speed off, exiting onto E. Trinity Mills road at approximately 80-90mph.
14. Officer Tittle managed to catch up to Crawford on Mc Coy Road where Crawford was travelling 50mph in a 35mph zone, where he eventually slowed to 30mph and activated his hazards and backed into a driveway.

15. Officer Tittle approached the vehicle and requested Crawford to put the vehicle in park and exit, but Crawford refused multiple times before finally exiting. After Crawford exited, Officer Tittle was able to smell alcohol on Crawford's person.
16. Crawford was arrested for felony Evading Arrest and Driving While Intoxicated. Crawford was charged with felony Evading Arrest because he continued to drive for 1.75 miles with a marked police squad car behind him that had its emergency lights and sirens activated.
17. Crawford refused sobriety tests at the scene, but a blood sample was later collected. The felony Evading Arrest offense is still pending in Cause No.: F-24387816, in the 16th District Court, Denton County, Texas and the misdemeanor DWI offense is still pending in Cause No. CR-2024-05950-A, in Denton County, Texas.

Legal Allegations

1. Crawford committed acts for which a license may be denied pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.102.
2. Crawford has been convicted of a felony, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(8).
3. Crawford has committed offenses that directly relate to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation, as contemplated by 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.502(c)-(f).
4. Crawford committed offenses that the department considers to be of such a serious nature that they are of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure, as contemplated by TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.502(c)-(e), 1.502(f)(4)(F), and 1.502(f)(4)(R), and TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023.
5. Department guidelines, 28 TEX. ADMIN. Code § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that the department:
 - a. considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;

- b. may refuse to issue an original license if the department determines that the applicant as committed a felony or misdemeanor that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation;
- c. considers the felony offenses of Aggravated Assault-Deadly Weapon, Assault-Family Violence, and Intoxication Assault to be of such a serious nature that they are of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure, TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.502(c)-(e), 1.502(f)(4)(F), and 1.502(f)(4)(R).

Relief Sought

TDI seeks the following relief:

- 1. denial of your license application; and
- 2. imposition of any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.






