**General remarks and official action taken:**

This is a default order taken against D Anthony Elijah Simms Coleman (Respondent) because Respondent committed acts for which a license may be revoked when he committed serious criminal offenses directly related to the business of insurance. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Allegations mailed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

**Findings of Fact**

Failure to Respond to Notice of Allegations

1. On May 23, 2025, the department sent a Notice of Allegations, attached as Exhibit A, to Respondent.
2. The department sent the Notice of Allegations to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, [REDACTED], Houston Texas 77070.
3. Respondent received and waived an opportunity for a hearing because Respondent failed to send the department a written response to the Notice of Allegations within 20 days after the date the Notice of Allegations was mailed.

4. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

## Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, and 4054.301; TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051-2001.178.
2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
3. The department provided proper notice to Respondent under TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1), 2001.051, 2001.052, 2001.054, and 2001.056(4), and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.47, and 19.906.
4. Based on Respondent's failure to send the department a written response to the Notice of Allegations, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
5. Respondent failed to show compliance with the law.
6. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.

## Order

It is ordered that any licenses held by D Anthony Elijah Simms Coleman are revoked. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.





## Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.301, TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021–53.023, 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502, and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051–2001.178.

## Factual Allegations

### Licensure

1. D Athony Elijah Simms Coleman (Coleman), individual identification no. 2709116, holds a life agent license issued by the Texas Department of Insurance on March 16, 2023.

### Criminal History

2. According to the Complaint in Cause No. 187313901010 in the 209th District Court of Harris County, Texas, charging Coleman with Felony Aggravated Robbery – Deadly Weapon, on or about June 14, 2024, Coleman did unlawfully, while committing theft, intentionally and knowingly threaten and place an Academy Sports and Outdoors (Academy) cashier in fear of imminent bodily injury and death, and Coleman did use and exhibit a deadly weapon, namely a firearm.
3. According to the Complaint in Cause No. 187253401010 in the 209th District Court of Harris County, Texas, charging Coleman with Felony Aggravated Assault, on or about June 14, 2024, Coleman intentionally and knowingly threatened with imminent bodily injury Deputy D.F. by using and exhibiting a deadly weapon, namely a firearm, knowing that Deputy D.F. was a public servant.
4. According to the Complaint in Cause No. 251547401010 in the 4th Criminal court at law of Harris County, Texas, charging Coleman with misdemeanor Theft, on or about June 14, 2024, Coleman did unlawfully appropriate five boxes of ammunition from Academy with a value of at least one hundred dollars but less than seven hundred fifty dollars, with the intent to deprive Academy of the property.

## Legal Allegations

1. Coleman committed acts for which a license may be revoked pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.102.

2. Coleman willfully violated an insurance law of this state, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(1).
3. Coleman has committed an offense that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation, as contemplated in 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.502(c)-(f).
4. Coleman committed an offense that the department considers to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure, as contemplated by 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.502(c)-(f) and TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023.
5. Department guidelines, 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.502(c)-(e), 1.502(f)(4)(F), 1.502(f)(4)(I), and 1.502(f)(4)(K) emphasize the department:
  - a. Considers it very important that license holders be honest, trustworthy, and reliable due to the special nature of the relationship between licenses, insurance companies, and the public;
  - b. May revoke a license if the department determines the license holder has committed a felony or engaged in fraudulent or dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; and
  - c. Considers the criminal offenses of Aggravated Robbery - Deadly Weapon, Aggravated Assault, and Theft to be of such a serious nature that they are of prime importance in determining whether to revoke a license. 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.502(c)-(e), 1.502(f)(4)(F), 1.502(f)(4)(I), and 1.502(f)(4)(K).

## Relief Sought

TDI seeks the following relief:

1. revocation of your license; and
2. imposition of any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.


