General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Sean Baylon Douglas Scott (Respondent) because he attempted to file a false and fraudulent insurance claim for damage to his vehicle, failed to disclose criminal history in his application to TDI, and failed to timely notify TDI of an administrative action taken against him. Respondent did not appear at the hearing on the merits. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Appear at Hearing on the Merits

1. On July 8, 2025, the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) filed a Notice of Hearing, together with a previously filed Original Petition and Scheduling Order, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings, and which attached documents were admitted as Exhibit 1 at the hearing on the merits.
2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition (Exhibit A) are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

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3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing, Original Petition, and Scheduling Order together to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, [REDACTED], Fort Worth, TX 76177. The Notice of Hearing, Original Petition, and Scheduling Order were also sent by electronic mail.
4. After being properly served the notice of the date, time and location of the hearing on the merits, Respondent failed to appear for the hearing on September 22, 2025, and the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) has remanded this matter to the commissioner for informal disposition by default, as shown in the record in SOAH Docket No. 454-25-21771.C.

Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4101.051; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051–2001.178.
2. Based on Respondent's failure to appear in person or by legal representative at the hearing, the commissioner has authority to informally dispose of this case by default under Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.056(4) and 2001.058(d-1), and Tex. Ins. Code § 82.055.
3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing under Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054; Tex. Ins. Code § 4001.252(a)(1); and, 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.28 and 19.906.
4. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and were deemed admitted as true by SOAH under 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.501(d)(1).

Order

It is ordered that any licenses held by Sean Baylon Douglas Scott are revoked. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.



NOTICE OF HEARING

The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) seeks to take disciplinary action against you. This Notice of Hearing and the Original Petition, which is attached and incorporated for all purposes, states the allegations against you and the relief sought by TDI.

A public hearing will be held before an Administrative Law Judge on **Monday, September 22, 2025, at 9:00 a.m.** The hearing will take place via videoconference using a videoconference platform controlled by the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH), unless otherwise ordered to proceed in another manner by the Administrative Law Judge. The attached SOAH scheduling order includes the hyperlink and telephone contact information to attend the videoconference hearing.

The hearing will be conducted under TEX. GOV'T CODE, ch. 2001 and 1 TEX. ADMIN. CODE, ch. 155. Unless otherwise directed by the Administrative Law Judge, the hearing will continue from day to day on the videoconference platform until concluded, unless otherwise ordered by the Administrative Law Judge. You have the right to appear at this hearing and to be represented by an attorney.

Parties that are not represented by an attorney may obtain information regarding contested case hearings on the public website of the State Office of Administrative Hearings at www.soah.texas.gov, or in printed format upon request to SOAH.

Your failure to appear on the day and time set for the hearing entitles TDI to move to proceed on a default basis, under 1 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 155.501. If you don't appear, SOAH may grant TDI's motion, deem the allegations against you as true, and issue a default dismissal or default proposal for decision. The Commissioner of

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Insurance may then issue a default order granting the relief sought, including revocation of your license, issuance of a cease and desist order, imposition of administrative penalties, payment of restitution, and/or denial of your license application.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Sean Baylon Douglas Scott. In support of this petition, TDI makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4101.051; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051–2001.178.

Factual Allegations

1. Sean Baylon Douglas Scott (Scott) holds an Adjuster All Lines license originally issued by TDI on January 3, 2024.

Agent Misconduct:

1. On February 8, 2024, Scott submitted a claim to GEICO for vehicle damage that resulted from a car accident he was involved in. Scott and his vehicle were insured with liability coverage only under his mother's GEICO auto policy. The incident was reported to have occurred at 7 a.m. Central Standard Time (CST).
2. No payments were made on Scott's claim because the policy did not include collision or comprehensive coverage for his vehicle. Scott did not make any repairs to his vehicle.

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Original Petition

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3. On February 8, 2024, at 8:24 a.m. CST, Scott's mother added comprehensive and collision coverage for Scott's vehicle to her auto policy.
4. On April 7, 2024, Scott filed a second claim with GEICO claiming he discovered new damage to his vehicle. Scott believed the new damage resulted from his vehicle being hit while parked at his apartment complex on March 18, 2024.
5. After investigating the claim on April 9, 2024, GEICO determined that there was no new damage to Scott's vehicle and the damage claimed by Scott resulted from his prior accident in February 2024. Scott dropped his claim after GEICO informed him of its findings.

Undisclosed Criminal History in his License Application:

6. Scott applied for his adjuster's license on December 28, 2023. When asked on his application if "he had ever been convicted of a felony, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony" Scott answered, "No."
7. On May 9, 2016, in Case No. 1447466 in the Criminal District Court No. 3, Tarrant County, Texas, Scott pleaded guilty to Attempt to Bring a Prohibited Substance or Item in a Correctional Facility, a state jail felony. The court placed Scott on deferred adjudication community supervision for two years.
8. On June 18, 2018, Scott was discharged from community supervision and his case was dismissed.

Administrative Action:

9. On May 15, 2024, the Florida Department of Financial Services denied Scott's application for a non-resident All Lines Adjuster license. Scott's application was denied for his criminal history and failing to disclose it on his application.
10. Scott did not notify TDI of the administrative action taken against him by Florida.

Legal Allegations

1. Scott committed an act for which a license may be revoked, as contemplated by TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023, TEX. INS. CODE §4005.101, and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502.
2. Scott willfully violated a Texas insurance law, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(1).
3. Scott intentionally made a material misstatement in his license application, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(2).
4. Scott obtained or attempted to obtain a license by fraud or misrepresentation, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(3).
5. Scott engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).
6. Scott failed to notify TDI of an administrative action taken against him, as required by TEX. INS. CODE § 4001.252.

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, TDI asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

1. revoking Sean Baylon Douglas Scott's license;
2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.

INITIAL ORDER

1. **Case Referred.** This case has been docketed at the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) and assigned to the undersigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). 3. **Notice.** Staff for the Texas Department of Insurance must issue a notice of hearing. Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051–.052.
4. **Three Business Days Before the Hearing.** The following must be done at least three business days before the hearing. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in the exclusion of evidence.
 - a. **Exhibits:**
 - Make an exhibit list;
 - Number each exhibit sequentially; and
 - Paginate or bates stamp multipage documents.
 - b. **Witness List:**
 - Identify each witness you will call to testify;
 - Mention what each witness will testify about; and
 - Estimate how long each witness will testify.
 - c. **Witnesses:**
 - Give each witness the information to access the hearing;

- Give each witness the documents needed to participate in the hearing;
- Have each witness's contact information available so additional documents can be provided to each witness during the hearing if needed.

d. **Upload Your Exhibit List, Exhibits, and Witness List.**


