**General remarks and official action taken:**

This is a consent order with Acrisure, LLC. Acrisure, LLC failed to timely file surplus lines policies and related documents. Acrisure, LLC has agreed to pay an administrative penalty of \$6,025 for these violations.

**Waiver**

Acrisure, LLC acknowledges that the Texas Insurance Code and other applicable law provide certain rights. Acrisure, LLC waives all of these rights, and any other applicable procedural rights, in consideration of the entry of this consent order.

**Findings of Fact**

1. Acrisure, LLC, license number 1683887 holds a surplus lines license issued by the Texas Department of Insurance.
2. Pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a), a surplus lines insurance agent must file with the Surplus Lines Stamping Office of Texas either:
  - a. a copy of the policy issued or
  - b. if the policy has not yet been issued, a copy of the certificate, cover note, or other confirmation of insurance delivered to the insured.

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This information is due not later than the 60th day after the later of the effective date or the issue date of new or renewal surplus lines insurance.

3. In 2024, Acrisure, LLC filed surplus lines policies and related documents late.
4. The commissioner previously disciplined Acrisure, LLC for violating TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a) in: Official Order No. 2020-6579, entered on November 30, 2020; Official Order No. 2023-8254, entered on October 3, 2023; and, Official Order No. 2024-8880, entered on October 3, 2024.

## Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 84.021-84.044, and 981.105.
2. The commissioner of insurance has authority to informally dispose of this matter under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056, and TEX. INS. CODE §§ 36.104 and 82.055.
3. Acrisure, LLC has knowingly and voluntarily waived all procedural rights to which it may have been entitled regarding the entry of this order, including, but not limited to, issuance and service of notice of intention to institute disciplinary action, notice of hearing, a public hearing, a proposal for decision, rehearing by the commissioner, and judicial review.
4. Acrisure, LLC violated TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a) by failing to timely file new or renewal surplus lines policies and related documents.

## Order

It is ordered that Acrisure, LLC must pay an administrative penalty of \$6,025 within 30 days from the date of this order. The administrative penalty must be paid as instructed in the invoice, which the department will send after entry of this order.

This consent order pertains solely to the resolution of TDI's allegations against Acrisure, LLC in TDI Enforcement File No. 37503. This consent order does not: resolve any allegations or violations with respect to any other pending or anticipated Enforcement investigations; address or impact other TDI sections' and divisions' actions, proceedings, examinations, investigations, or duties; limit the authority of the commissioner or TDI to initiate any administrative, civil, or criminal proceeding; or, limit the authority of the


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commissioner or TDI to initiate any action, seek any remedy, or pursue any right, examination, investigation, or other action authorized by law.
