General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Christopher Jamal Oney (Respondent) because he is currently on deferred adjudication for sexual assault set to end on or about March 25, 2036. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Allegations mailed by the TDI. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Allegations

1. On June 26, 2026, TDI sent a Notice of Allegations, attached as Exhibit A, to Respondent.
2. TDI sent the Notice of Allegations to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, [REDACTED] Fort Worth, Texas 76108. TDI also sent the Notice of Allegations to Respondent's electronic mail address he last designated for receipt of official department communications, and to an additional address associated with Respondent: [REDACTED], Fort Worth, Texas 76106.

3. TDI gave Respondent notice and opportunity for a hearing, which Respondent waived by failing to send a written response to the Notice of Allegations within 20 days after the date it was mailed.
4. TDI's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, 4101.05, and 4054.3011; TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051-2001.178.
2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
3. TDI provided proper notice to Respondent under TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1), 2001.051, 2001.052, 2001.054, and 2001.056(4); and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.1302, 1.28, 1.47, and 19.906.
4. Based on Respondent's failure to send TDI a written response to the Notice of Allegations, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
5. Respondent failed to show compliance with the law.
6. TDI's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.

Order

It is ordered that any licenses held by Christopher Jamal Oney are revoked. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.

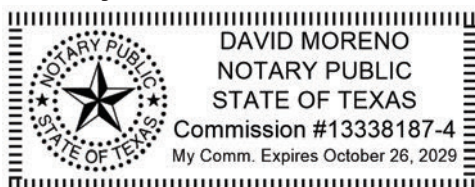

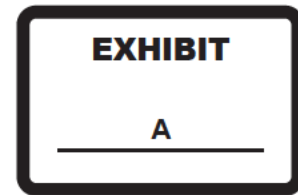

NOTICE OF ALLEGATIONS AGAINST CHRISTOPHER JAMAL ONEY

The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) seeks to take disciplinary action against you. This Notice states the allegations against you and the relief sought by TDI.

YOUR WRITTEN RESPONSE IS REQUIRED WITHIN 20 DAYS

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO A HEARING AND ARE INVITED TO SHOW COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW. To request a hearing, you must send a written response to TDI within 20 days of the date this Notice was mailed.

If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, *you waive your right to a hearing*, and TDI may seek disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47, TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055, and TEX. GOV'T. CODE § 2001.056.

If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, without further notice to you, the commissioner of insurance may issue a default order that admits the factual matters asserted, deems all allegations as true, and orders the relief recommended in this Notice.

Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.301; TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021–53.023; 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051–2001.178.

Factual Allegations

1. Christopher Jamal Oney (Oney) has a Life Agent license issued by TDI on May 5, 2025. This license is currently set to expire on March 31, 2027.
2. On November 5, 2025, in Cause No. 35794CR, in the 196th Judicial District Court of Hunt County, Texas, Oney was indicted for sexual assault.
3. On December 18, 2025, TDI sent a letter to Oney informing him that TDI had received notification he had a pending criminal charge that he failed to disclose. The letter informed Oney that he was required to provide TDI with copies of documentation relating to any criminal activity. TDI received no response from Oney.
4. On March 25, 2026, in Cause No. 35794CR, in the 196th Judicial District Court of Hunt County, Texas, Oney pleaded guilty to sexual assault and was sentenced to 10 years deferred adjudication.
5. Oney was further ordered to register as a sex offender.
6. Oney's period of deferred adjudication is projected to end on or about March 25, 2036.

Legal Allegations

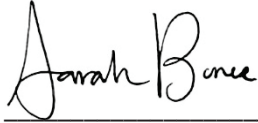
1. TDI may revoke Oney's license because he can be considered to be convicted of an offense listed in Article 42A.054 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, as contemplated by TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.021(a)(2), (d)(1)(B)(i), (d)(2); and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(d)(2).
2. TDI may revoke Oney's license because he can be considered to be convicted of an offense described by Article 62.001(6) of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, as contemplated by TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.021(a)(3), (d)(1)(A), and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(d)(3).
3. TDI may revoke Oney's license because he has been placed on deferred adjudication for a crime of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure, as contemplated by 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(d)(2), (d)(3), (f)(4)(F), (f)(5), and (f)(6).
4. The factors referenced in 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(g), listed in TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.022(1)-(5) and 53.023(a)(1)-(7), do not outweigh the seriousness of Oney's criminal offense, as 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(f) contemplates.

Relief Sought

TDI seeks the following relief:

1. revocation of your license; and
2. imposition of any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.

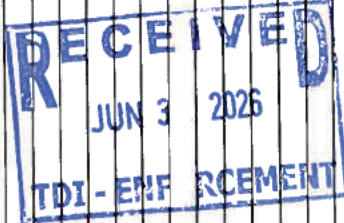
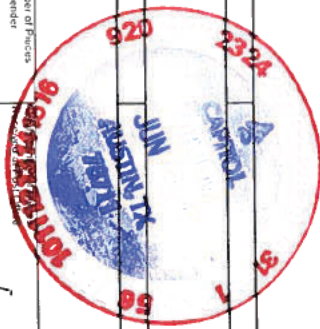
