General remarks and official action taken:

This is a consent order with Charles Taylor TPA, LLC (Charles Taylor), formerly known as Underwriters Safety and Claims, Inc, because it failed to comply with requirements to maintain its third party administrator (TPA) certificate of authority. Charles Taylor has agreed to pay an administrative penalty of \$2,500.

Waiver

Charles Taylor acknowledges that the Texas Insurance Code and other applicable law provide certain rights. Charles Taylor waives all of these rights, and any other applicable procedural rights, in consideration of the entry of this consent order.

Findings of Fact

1. On March 14, 2008, TDI issued Charles Taylor a third party administrator (TPA) certificate of authority no. 2988770.
2. Texas law states that TPA certificates of authority are effective until suspended, canceled, or revoked.

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Commissioner's Order
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3. TPAs must file annual reports by June 30th of each year covering the preceding calendar year. The report must include an audited financial statement performed by an independent certified public accountant.
4. TPAs must pay a non-refundable \$200 filing fee for each annual report.
5. A TPA is subject to discipline, including revocation of its certificate of authority, if it fails to timely file its annual report.
6. Charles Taylor failed to file its annual report for calendar year 2024 and failed to pay the associated \$200 filing fees for calendar years 2023-2024.
7. Charles Taylor has now filed its delinquent annual reports and paid the associated filing fees.

Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 4151.051, 4151.056, 4151.205, 4151.206, 4151.212, 4151.301–4151.309; TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1), 2001.051–2001.178; and, 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 7.1601, 7.1603, and 7.1609.
2. The commissioner has authority to informally dispose of this matter as set forth under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056 and TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.055 and 36.104.
3. Charles Taylor has knowingly and voluntarily waived all procedural rights to which it may have been entitled regarding the entry of this order, including, but not limited to, issuance and service of notice of intention to institute disciplinary action, notice of hearing, a public hearing, a proposal for decision, rehearing by the commissioner, and judicial review.
4. Charles Taylor failed to timely file annual TPA reports by June 30th on a form prescribed by the commissioner, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE §§ 4151.205 and 4151.301(14), and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 7.1609.
5. Charles Taylor failed to pay the annual \$200 TPA filing fee in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4151.206(a)(3) and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 7.1609(a).

6. Charles Taylor has willfully violated an insurance law of this state, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4151.301(1).
7. Charles Taylor has willfully violated a commissioner rule, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4151.301(10).

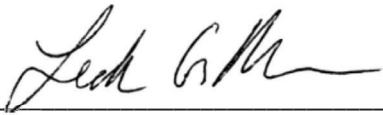
Order

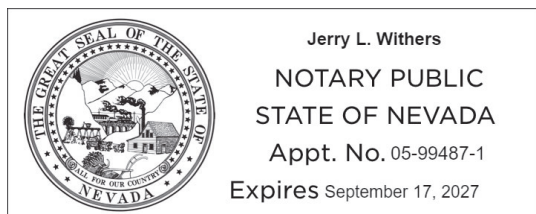
