General remarks and official action taken:

This is a consent order with Hull & Company, LLC. Hull & Company, LLC. failed to timely file surplus lines policies and related documents. Hull & Company, LLC. has agreed to pay an administrative penalty of \$4,925 for these violations.

Waiver

Hull & Company, LLC. acknowledges that the Texas Insurance Code and other applicable law provide certain rights. Hull & Company, LLC. waives all of these rights, and any other applicable procedural rights, in consideration of the entry of this consent order.

Findings of Fact

1. Hull & Company, LLC., license number 1394327, holds a surplus lines license issued by the Texas Department of Insurance.
2. Pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a), a surplus lines insurance agent must file with the Surplus Lines Stamping Office of Texas either:
 - a. a copy of the policy issued or
 - b. if the policy has not yet been issued, a copy of the certificate, cover note, or other confirmation of insurance delivered to the insured.

This information is due not later than the 60th day after the later of the effective date or the issue date of new or renewal surplus lines insurance.

3. In 2024, Hull & Company, LLC. filed surplus lines policies and related documents late.
4. The commissioner previously disciplined Hull & Company, LLC. for violating TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a) in Official Order No. 3388 entered on July 7, 2014; Official Order No. 2021-6654 entered on January 15, 2021; and Official Order No. 2024-8824 entered on September 16, 2024.

Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 84.021-84.044, and 981.105.
2. The commissioner of insurance has authority to informally dispose of this matter under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056, and TEX. INS. CODE §§ 36.104 and 82.055.
3. Hull & Company, LLC. has knowingly and voluntarily waived all procedural rights to which it may have been entitled regarding the entry of this order, including, but not limited to, issuance and service of notice of intention to institute disciplinary action, notice of hearing, a public hearing, a proposal for decision, rehearing by the commissioner, and judicial review.
4. Hull & Company, LLC. violated TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a) by failing to timely file new or renewal surplus lines policies and related documents.

Order




