General remarks and official action taken:

This is a consent order with Brenham Abstract & Title Company (Brenham Abstract). Brenham Abstract failed to timely file its 2024 title insurance agent statistical report. Respondent has agreed to pay an administrative penalty of \$3,500.

Waiver

Brenham Abstract acknowledges that the Texas Insurance Code and other applicable law provide certain rights. Brenham Abstract waives all of these rights, and any other applicable procedural rights, in consideration of the entry of this consent order.

Findings of Fact

1. Brenham Abstract, firm identification number 92643, holds a title agency license issued by the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) on May 9, 2007.

Late-Filed 2024 Statistical Report

2. On March 14, 2025, TDI issued Bulletin No. B-0001-25 to Texas title insurance agents regarding the 2024 Title Insurance Agent Data Call for the reporting period

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of January 1 through December 31, 2024. The bulletin required submission of business data by April 8, 2025, for TDI's use in setting title insurance premium rates.

3. Brenham Abstract did not submit its statistical report by April 8, 2025, and was listed as a non-reporter in TDI's 2024 Texas Title Insurance Agent Experience Report Compilation.
4. On May 7, 2025, Brenham Abstract filed its statistical report with TDI, 29 days late.

Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 84.021–84.044, 2651.301, and 2703.153.
2. The commissioner has the authority to informally dispose of this matter as set forth in TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056, and TEX. INS. CODE §§ 36.104 and 82.055.
3. Brenham Abstract has knowingly and voluntarily waived all procedural rights to which it may have been entitled regarding the entry of this order, including, but not limited to, issuance and service of notice of intention to institute disciplinary action, notice of hearing, a public hearing, a proposal for decision, rehearing by the commissioner, and judicial review.
4. Brenham Abstract violated TEX. INS. CODE § 2703.153 by failing to timely submit its 2024 statistical report.

Order

It is ordered that Brenham Abstract pay an administrative penalty of \$3,500 within 30 days from the date of this order. The administrative penalty must be paid as instructed in the invoice, which the department will send after entry of this order.


