General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether a general lines agent license should be issued to Trevor John Taylor (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Allegations mailed by the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI). This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Allegations

1. On March 31, 2026, TDI sent a Notice of Allegations, attached as Exhibit A, to Respondent.
2. TDI sent the Notice of Allegations to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, [REDACTED] Sugar Land, TX 77478. TDI also sent the Notice of Allegations to Respondent's electronic mail address he last designated for receipt of official department communications.
3. Respondent received and waived an opportunity for a hearing because Respondent failed to send TDI a written response to the Notice of Allegations within 20 days after the date the Notice of Allegations was mailed.

4. TDI's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, and 4051.051; TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051-2001.178.
2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
3. TDI provided proper notice to Respondent under TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1), 2001.051, 2001.052, 2001.054, and 2001.056(4); and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.1302, 1.28, 1.47, and 19.906.
4. Based on Respondent's failure to send TDI a written response to the Notice of Allegations, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
5. Respondent failed to show compliance with the law.
6. TDI's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.

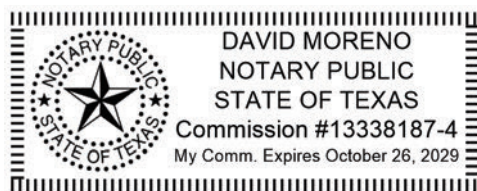

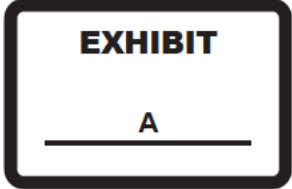

NOTICE OF ALLEGATIONS AGAINST TREVOR JOHN TAYLOR**

The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) seeks to deny your license application. This Notice states the allegations against you and the relief sought by TDI.

YOUR WRITTEN RESPONSE IS REQUIRED WITHIN 20 DAYS

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO A HEARING AND ARE INVITED TO SHOW COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW. To request a hearing, you must send a written response to TDI within 20 days of the date this Notice was mailed.

If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, *you waive your right to a hearing*, and TDI may seek disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47, TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055, and TEX. GOV'T. CODE § 2001.056.

If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, without further notice to you, the commissioner of insurance may issue a default order that admits the factual matters asserted, deems all allegations as true, and orders the relief recommended in this Notice.

Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.051; TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021–53.023; 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051–2001.178.

Factual Allegations

Application and Proposed Denial

1. On August 12, 2025, Trevor John Taylor (Taylor) submitted an application for a general lines agent license with a qualification in property and casualty, in which he disclosed a criminal history that included both misdemeanor¹ and felony offenses.
2. On October 7, 2025, TDI proposed to deny Taylor's license application based on his criminal history, and on Oct 16, 2025, Taylor made a timely request for a hearing.

Case No. 080158-A-CR; 47th District Court, Potter County, TX

3. On September 8, 2021, Taylor pleaded guilty to felony assault of a family or household member by impeding breath or circulation², in exchange for a deferred adjudication of guilt with 4 years community supervision probation.
4. On August 8, 2022, Taylor was adjudicated guilty and was sentenced to a 10-year suspended sentence and was placed under 5 years community supervision probation.
5. On July 19, 2023, Taylor's community supervision probation was revoked and he was sentenced to 5 years in the institutional division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, to run concurrent with his other sentences.

¹ TDI did not consider Taylor's misdemeanor crimes in determining fitness for licensure because they were dismissed after Taylor successfully completed deferred adjudication probation more than 5 years prior to applying for licensure.

Case Nos. 32062B & 32953B; 181st District Court, Randall County, TX

6. On June 28, 2023, Taylor pleaded guilty to two counts of felony assault³, committed on March 2, 2022 and April 2, 2023, and was sentenced to serve 5 years concurrent with his other sentences.

Case No. 084022-A-CR; 47th District Court, Potter County, TX

7. On July 19, 2023, Taylor pleaded guilty to felony assault of a family or household member with a prior conviction⁴ and was sentenced to serve 5 years concurrent with his other sentences.

Parole

8. On June 6, 2025, Taylor was released on parole with an anticipated completion date of April 6, 2028.

Legal Allegations

1. TDI may deny Taylor's license application because he has been convicted of a felony, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(8).
2. TDI may deny Taylor's license because he committed an offense that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the professional license he is seeking as contemplated by TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.021(a)(1) and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(d)(1).
3. TDI rules specifically lists assault offenses under Penal Code Chapter 22, to be of such a serious nature that they are of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure, under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(f)(4)(F).
4. The factors considered under TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.022-53.023 and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502-1.503 do not outweigh the serious nature of Taylor's criminal offenses.

TDI seeks the following relief:

1. denial of your license application, and
2. the imposition of any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
