**General remarks and official action taken:**

This is a default order taken against Patrick Aaron Pistor (Respondent) because he failed to notify the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) of the administrative action against him, failed to respond to TDI's official inquiry, and does not have an appointment to act as an agent. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Allegations mailed by TDI. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

**Findings of Fact**

Failure to Respond to Notice of Allegations

1. On March 27, 2026, TDI sent a Notice of Allegations, attached as Exhibit A, to Respondent.
2. TDI sent the Notice of Allegations to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, [REDACTED], New Braunfels, TX 78132.
3. Respondent received and waived an opportunity for a hearing because Respondent failed to send TDI a written response to the Notice of Allegations within 20 days after the date the Notice of Allegations was mailed.

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4. TDI's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

## Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, and 4054.051; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051-2001.178.
2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
3. TDI provided proper notice to Respondent under TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1), 2001.051, 2001.052, 2001.054, and 2001.056(4); and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.1302, 1.28, 1.47, and 19.906.
4. Based on Respondent's failure to send TDI a written response to the Notice of Allegations, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
5. Respondent failed to show compliance with the law.
6. TDI's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Allegations are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.

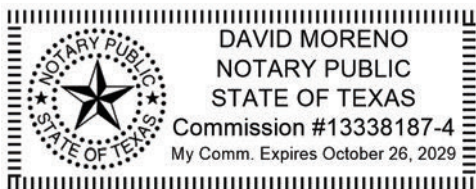

NOTICE OF ALLEGATIONS AGAINST PATRICK AARON PISTOR**

The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) seeks to take disciplinary action against you. This notice states the allegations against you and the relief sought by TDI.

***YOUR WRITTEN RESPONSE IS REQUIRED WITHIN 20 DAYS***

**YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO A HEARING AND ARE INVITED TO SHOW COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW.** To request a hearing, you must send a written response to TDI within 20 days of the date this Notice was mailed.

If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, *you waive your right to a hearing*, and TDI may seek disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47, TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055, and TEX. GOV'T. CODE § 2001.056.

If you fail to send a written response by the deadline, without further notice to you, the commissioner of insurance may issue a default order that admits the factual matters asserted, deems all allegations as true, and orders the relief recommended in this Notice.

## Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 84.021–84.044, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4054.051; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.003(1) and 2001.051–2001.178.

## Factual Allegations

1. Patrick Aaron Pistor (Pistor) holds a general lines agent license with a qualification in life, accident, health, and HMO issued by TDI on April 19, 2022.
2. In September 2022, Pistor was registered with the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (FINRA), central registration depository (CRD) number 7579598, as a broker for the firm, Equitable Advisors, LLC (Equitable).
3. On February 3, 2025, Equitable discharged Pistor for failure to comply with the firms outside business activity policy.
4. On February 6, 2025, Pistor's company appointments were terminated.<sup>1</sup>
5. On June 17, 2025, FINRA suspended Pistor for his failure to respond to FINRA's requests for information.
6. On September 22, 2025, FINRA permanently barred Pistor from the securities industry.
7. Pistor failed to disclose the FINRA administrative actions to TDI within 30 days.
8. On December 29, 2025, TDI sent an inquiry letter via certified mail to Pistor's address of record requesting information about the FINRA administrative actions against him.
9. On January 6, 2026, TDI received signed confirmation from the United States Postal Service of delivery of the inquiry letter to Pistor's address of record.

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<sup>1</sup> Pistor only had two appointments: Equitable Financial Life Insurance Company, and Equitable Financial Life Insurance Company of America; both of which became inactive on February 6, 2025.

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10. On February 2, 2026, TDI sent a second inquiry letter via certified mail to Pistor's address of record requesting information about the FINRA administrative actions.
11. TDI did not receive a response to the inquiry letters sent to Pistor.

## Legal Allegations

1. Pistor committed acts for which he may be disciplined under TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101, including revocation of her license, as contemplated under TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.102.
2. Pistor failed to notify TDI of the administrative actions against him, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4001.252(a)(3).
3. Pistor failed to respond to TDI's official inquiry, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 38.001.
4. Pistor does not have an appointment as required under TEX. INS. CODE § 4001.201 to engage as an agent soliciting or writing insurance for the public as required under TEX. INS. CODE § 4001.104 , in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(10).

## Relief Sought

TDI seeks the following relief:

1. revocation of your license, and
2. the imposition of any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.

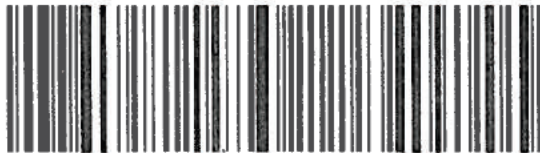
