

Individual Renewal Application for Firework Operator's License

Instructions

- Please print or type your information.
- To renew your license:
 - Your renewal must be postmarked before your license expiration date.
 - Your renewal application must be complete.
- A late fee is required for renewal applications that are not postmarked by your current license expiration date (see fee schedule on last page). A late fee is also required if you submit an incomplete application and do not provide the missing information by your license expiration date or within the 30-day notice period allowed by the fireworks rules.
- All fees are nonrefundable, except for overpayments from mistakes of law or fact.
- Send one payment to cover fees. Payments for various applications must be combined.
- Answer questions completely and truthfully. We may deny, suspend, or revoke your license if you misrepresent or knowingly give wrong information on this application.
