TDI Background

In 2023, the Texas Legislature passed <u>House Bill 3359</u>, which amended <u>Texas Insurance Code 1301</u>. The new requirements of the bill:

- Strengthens network adequacy standards.
 - Sets travel time and distance standards based on county designation.
 - Sets maximum appointment wait time standards.
- Permits insurers to request a network standard waiver. For example:
 - Not enough cardiologists within 10 miles from an enrollee living in a large metro county.
 - Not enough neonatologists within a facility.
- Requires TDI to hold a public hearing before granting waivers.

TDI Hearing notices

- All hearings will be on Zoom.
- TDI will post the hearing notice at least two weeks in advance.
 - Hearing schedule is on the <u>Agency calendar</u>.
 - TDI will post the recordings on the <u>Network adequacy archived recordings</u> page.
- Sign up to receive email notices through GovDelivery.
- Insurers will be notified through SERFF.
- Physicians and providers that insurers tried to contract with will get hearing notices.

TDI Submit evidence

Anyone can give evidence by:

- Speaking at a hearing:
 - Complete the <u>witness registration form</u> two business days before the hearing, if possible.
 - TDI may limit speaking time to let all witnesses to speak.
- Submitting written evidence:
 - Email <u>NetworkWaivers@tdi.texas.gov</u>. Use the subject "SERFF ID#" and include specific ID number.
 - TDI will accept written submissions up to one week after the hearing.

TDI Texas Open Data Portal (ODP)

Network data will be published into three datasets on the Texas ODP.

- Datasets can be filtered and sorted. Datasets include:
 - Major medical: compliance with time and distance standards.
 - <u>Facility-based providers</u>: adequacy within in-network hospitals and other facilities.
 - Vision: shows network adequacy for vision plans.
- Users can create and save reports.
