**ORDER APPROVING FINAL REPORT OF CLAIMS AND AUTHORIZING FINAL  
DISTRIBUTION AND DESTRUCTION OF RECORDS AS TO  
UNIVERSAL INSURANCE EXCHANGE**

On this day came on to be heard the *Final Report of Claims and Application to Make Final Distribution and Destroy Records as to Universal Insurance Exchange* (Application) filed by DKJ Group, Inc., Special Deputy Receiver of Universal Insurance Exchange (SDR). The Application requests an order pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE ANN. §§ 443.253, 443.258, 443.301, 443.302 and 443.354, authorizing the final distribution, and the destruction of records.

In accordance with the *Order of Reference to Master* (Order of Reference), the Application was properly submitted to the Master appointed in this cause. The Master has issued a report pursuant to Rule 171 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, which is incorporated herein, finding and recommending as follows:

1. Notice of the hearing by submission of the Application was in accordance with the notice requirements of TEX. INS. CODE ANN. § 443.007, and the Order of Reference.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:

1. Exhibit A to the Application and Exhibits A-1 through A-10 attached thereto are admitted into evidence;

2. The Application is approved in all respects;

3. The estimated expenses of administration through the closing of the receivership in the amount of \$68,938.59 are approved;

4. The SDR is authorized to distribute the cash assets of the receivership as described in the Application and the SDR is authorized to withhold any distribution under \$100.00 as a *de minimis* amount;

5. The SDR is authorized to transfer to the Commissioner any residual funds remaining after all distributions are made;

6. The SDR is authorized to deliver all unclaimed funds to the Commissioner;


7. The SDR is authorized to transfer non-cash assets to the Commissioner;


8. The SDR's final report of claim is approved;

9. The SDR is authorized to dispose of the records listed in Exhibit A-10 and deliver any remaining records to the Commissioner, and authorizing the Commissioner to maintain or dispose of such records at his or her discretion; and

10. The SDR is authorized to execute all documents as necessary to effectuate the purposes of the Application and this Order.
