Subject Considered: TEXAS CATASTROPHE PROPERTY
INSURANCE POOL ACT
DESIGNATION OF CATASTROPHE AREAS

General remarks and official action taken:

Came on for consideration before the State Board of Insurance at its public hearing held May 26, 1971, the designation of Catastrophe Area or Areas which do not have Windstorm and Hail Insurance reasonably available to a substantial number of owners of insurable property within such area or areas.

After having duly considered all evidence presented and pursuant to Senate Bill 31, Acts of the 62nd Legislature 1971, the Board hereby designates the following counties as Windstorm and Hail Insurance Catastrophe Area(s):

Aransas, Brazoria, Calhoun, Cameron, Chambers, Galveston, Jefferson, Kenedy, Kleberg, Matagorda, Nueces, Refugio, San Patricio and Willacy.

Establishment of these areas is effective as of June 2, 1971.
