SECOND AMENDED NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF THE FINAL REPORT OF CLAIMS AND APPLICATION TO MAKE FINAL DISTRIBUTION FOR TEXAS SELECT LLOYDS INSURANCE COMPANY AND SELECT INSURANCE SERVICES, INC.

In accordance with the Supplemental Order of Reference to Master ("Order of Reference") entered in this cause, the Special Deputy Receiver’s Final Report of Claims and Application to Make Final Distribution for Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company (Texas Select) and Select Insurance Services, Inc. (Select Insurance), is set for submission before the Special Master, Tom Collins, ("Master") on Monday, November 11, 2024. The submission date has been changed from October 21, 2024 to November 11, 2024. Pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 443.007 (e) and TEX. R. CIV. P. 171, the Order of Reference has established the following rules:

1. The Master may consider the Application by written submission or oral hearing.
2. If no objection is filed in compliance with the Order of Reference, the Master may consider the Application without a hearing, and the Court may enter the order recommended by the Master

5. Any objection must specifically set out the reasons for the objection, with supporting references to and discussion of statutory and case authorities. Reasons not stated in writing will not be considered orally by the Master.
6. An objecting party must expeditiously coordinate with the Applicant's counsel and with the Master's docket clerk at (512) 676-6915 to request a hearing, unless the Master determines that a hearing is not necessary. If a hearing is granted, the objecting party must send a Notice of Oral Hearing to the Applicant's counsel and all parties listed on the Certificate of Service.
7. Any Acknowledgment of Notice and Waiver by a party in interest should be filed with the Court at least three (3) calendar days before the submission or hearing date.

FINAL REPORT OF CLAIMS AND APPLICATION TO MAKE FINAL DISTRIBUTION FOR TEXAS SELECT LLOYDS INSURANCE COMPANY AND SELECT INSURANCE SERVICES, INC.

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF THIS COURT:

Prime Tempus, Inc., Special Deputy Receiver (SDR) of Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation (Vesta Fire), Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company (Texas Select), and Select Insurance Services, Inc. (SIS) files this *Final Report of Claims and Application to Make Final Distribution for Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company and Select Insurance Services, Inc.* (Application), and respectfully shows the Court as follows:

I. RELIEF REQUESTED

1. The SDR has completed all claims processing and asset collection activities in this proceeding for Texas Select and SIS. The SDR submits its final report of claims for approval and requests this Court to authorize it to make a final distribution of the Texas Select and SIS receiverships' assets and dispose of or transfer any remaining records of Texas Select and of SIS to the Commissioner of Insurance (Commissioner). Following the completion of the final distributions, the SDR will submit an application to seek approval of a final accounting, dissolve the charter, discharge the Receiver and the SDR, and terminate this proceeding. This Application

does not affect the other companies made the subject of these receivership proceedings, except as described in this Application.

II. AUTHORITY

2. The SDR is authorized to file this Application under Chapter 443 of the Texas Insurance Code (Code). Under § 443.154(a) of the Code, the SDR has all the Receiver's powers, except as limited by the Receiver.

3. The subject matter of this Application is referred to the Master appointed in this proceeding under the Supplemental Order of Reference entered by the Court on November 8, 2006.

III. BACKGROUND

Company History

4. Texas Select is a domestic Lloyds plan insurer. SIS served as its last attorney-in-fact. Texas Select was licensed to underwrite insurance solely in Texas. Vesta Fire in receivership has an assignment of the rights of Texas Select's underwriters. Vesta Fire was assigned the rights of SIS's shareholder. Texas Select underwrote primarily homeowners policies.

Initiation of Receivership Proceeding

5. Texas Select and SIS were placed into rehabilitation on June 28, 2006, under the Agreed Order Appointing Rehabilitator and Permanent Injunction. Texas Select and SIS were placed into liquidation on August 1, 2006, under this Court's Order Appointing Liquidator and Permanent Injunction. (Liquidation Order).

Appointment of Receivers

6. The Commissioner was appointed Receiver on June 28, 2006, under the Insurer Receivership Act § 21A.151, now § 443.151 of the Code. Commissioner Cassie Brown is currently Receiver of Texas Select and SIS, and all predecessors have been discharged as Receiver by operation of law.

Appointment of Special Deputy Receiver

7. Prime Tempus, Inc. was appointed Special Deputy Receiver of Texas Select and SIS on or about July 11, 2006.

Referral to Master

8. On November 8, 2006, this Court entered a Supplemental Order of Reference to Master and referred this matter to Tom Collins as Master.

Guaranty Association Triggered

9. The Liquidation Order triggered the Texas Property and Casualty Insurance Guaranty Association in Texas as to Texas Select. That guaranty association became obligated to pay covered policyholder claims of Texas Select in accordance with its governing statutes.

IV. OFFER OF PROOF

10. The SDR offers into evidence the Affidavit of Craig A. Koenig and its supporting exhibits and requests that the Court admit these exhibits into evidence.

V. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

11. The following financial statements are attached to the Affidavit of Craig A. Koenig:

- The Statement of Net Assets as of June 30, 2024 for the receiverships of Texas Select and of SIS is attached as Exhibit A-1 and incorporated by reference.
- The Statement of Net Liabilities as of June 30, 2024 for the receiverships of Texas Select and of SIS is attached as Exhibit A-2 and incorporated by reference.
- The Disposition of Assets Schedule as of June 30, 2024 for the receiverships of Texas Select and of SIS is attached as Exhibit A-3 and incorporated by reference.
- The Sources and Uses of Cash Statement, which lists all funds received and disbursed by Texas Select and SIS from the date of receivership through June 30, 2024 is attached as Exhibit A-4 and incorporated by reference.

These Exhibits represent the final financial reports for the Texas Select and SIS receiverships under § 443.016 of the Code. The financial reports contain accounting adjustments made at various times during the life of the receiverships.

Notice

12. On April 3, 2007, this Court entered its Order Approving Notice and Setting Claims Filing Deadline. Under this Order, the SDR provided notice of the claim filing deadline to all persons who may have had claims as shown by Texas Select's and SIS's books and records. In addition, under this Order, the SDR published notice of the claims filing deadline in newspapers of general circulation in Texas, Alabama, California, West Virginia, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York, and nationally in the Wall Street Journal.

Filing of Claims as to Texas Select:

13. The following proofs of claim (POCs) were filed by the claim-filing deadline:

- (a) 1 secured claim;
- (b) 2 claims by guaranty associations for loss claims and handling expenses;
- (c) 931 claims under a policy;
- (d) 278 claims by general creditors;
- (e) 1 claim for surplus debenture;
- (f) 1 claim of the assignee of the underwriters;
- (g) 1 claim for debts due employees for services rendered;
- (h) 2 claims by state or local governments; and
- (i) 1 claim filed for interest owed.

There were 39 additional POCs filed after the claim-filing deadline.

Filing of Claims as to SIS:

14. The following POCs were filed by the claim-filing deadline:

- (a) No Secured claims;

- (b) 1 claim filed by a guaranty association for claims handling expenses, which was disallowed because SIS is not an insurer;
- (c) 19 Unsecured claims by general creditors;
- (d) 1 Claim of an equity holder;
- (e) 1 Claim for debt due employees for services rendered;
- (f) No Claims by state or local governments; and
- (g) 4 Claims filed by affiliate companies which were withdrawn.

There were no additional POCs filed after the claim-filing deadline.

Claims Processing for Texas Select

15. All claims representing potentially “covered claims” were referred to the guaranty association under § 443.253(m) of the Code. All POCs, except the shareholder Class 11 POCs against the receivership estate, were adjudicated under § 443.253(b) of the Code with respect to their classification and amount. The period allowed by § 443.253(c) of the Code to appeal the SDR’s action on claims has expired, and the SDR’s determination on these claims is final and not subject to review. The POCs were processed as follows:

- (a) The secured claim related to a premium bank account was approved and paid in the total amount of \$32,588.06.
- (b) The guaranty association’s Class 1 claim was approved and paid in the amount of \$12,577,575.53.
- (c) The guaranty association’s Class 2 claim was approved in the amount of \$90,682,536.38 and interim distributions of 50% were paid in the amount of \$45,341,268.19.
- (d) The approved Class 2 claims filed under a policy that were not payable by the guaranty associations totaled \$310,380.66. Prior approved interim distributions on these claims totaled \$155,190.37.
- (e) The employee claim was disallowed.
- (f) The claims of general creditors were approved in the amount of \$4,388,551.57.

- (g) The claims for state and local governments were approved in the amount of \$875.00.
- (h) Late filed POCs were approved in the amount of \$39,243.35.
- (i) The surplus debenture POC was approved in the amount of \$5,000,000.00.
- (j) The claim for interest owed was approved in the amount of \$501.12.
- (k) The surplus debenture claim was allowed.
- (l) The remaining underwriting funds will be disbursed to Vesta Fire as assignee of the underwriters under the terms of several trust agreements.

Claims Processing for SIS

16. SIS was an attorney-in-fact rather than an insurance company in its own right. No guaranty association coverage was involved with claims against SIS. All POCs, except the one POC filed by Texas Select, were adjudicated under § 443.253(b) of the Code with respect to their classification and amount. The period allowed by § 443.253(c) of the Code to appeal the SDR's action on claims has expired, and the SDR's determination on these claims is final and not subject to review. There was only one POC approved in this estate. That POC was originally filed by Vesta Insurance Group, Inc. and has since been assigned to Vesta Fire. That claim was approved as a Class 5 general creditor in the amount of \$8,469,038.

Claims Reports for Texas Select and SIS

17. Under § 443.258 of the Code, the SDR submitted reports of its determination of Texas Select claims, which were approved by this Court on September 28, 2009, September 3, 2010, February 11, 2011, February 27, 2012, December 18, 2013, May 21, 2018, and March 23, 2020. The SDR also submitted reports of its determination of SIS claims, which were approved by the Court on September 3, 2010, February 27, 2012, April 11, 2016, and February 16, 2017. The SDR submits its final report of claims for Texas Select and for SIS, which are attached as Exhibit A-5 to the Affidavit of Craig A. Koenig, and incorporated by reference. This exhibit includes all prior

claim approvals and the approval of the surplus debenture claim and the previously classified-only general creditor claim. The SDR requests that this order provide that late POCs may no longer be filed, as their filing would prejudice the orderly administration of the liquidation within the meaning of § 443.215(b) of the Code.

Distributions

18. During the course of the Texas Select receivership, a total of \$67,776,381 in early access payments were distributed to the Texas Property and Casualty Insurance Guaranty Association for Classes 1 and 2 claims under orders issued on May 21, 2008, February 2, 2009, May 11, 2009, January 15, 2010, May 15, 2010, November 23, 2010, December 20, 2011, December 17, 2012, and January 14, 2016.

19. During the course of the receivership, the SDR issued a 100% Class 1 distribution and a 50% interim distribution for Class 2 POCs allowed in the liquidation totaling \$58,074,034. This figure does not include payments issued during the period of rehabilitation and does not include releases of non-estate assets prior to liquidation. The financial statements for Texas Select and SIS will reflect these additional payments. The SDR has paid 100% of the approved Class 1 claims and 50% of the Class 2 claims as defined under § 443.301 of the Code. Guaranty associations were paid net of early access. SIS did not make any interim distributions.

VI. EXPENSES

Paid Expenses

20. On August 9, 2007, this Court approved the terms of compensation of the SDR and other contractors under § 443.015 of the Code. The compensation and administrative expenses of the Rehabilitator, Receiver, and SDR have been paid under that order through June 2024.

Closing Expenses

21. The SDR proposes to reserve \$99,900.00 for the payment of estimated expenses involved in closing the receiverships, as reflected on the detailed breakdown of estimated closing expenses, attached as Exhibit A-6 to the Affidavit of Craig A. Koenig, and incorporated by reference. The amounts paid by the SDR to each sub-contractor or service provider may vary from the line items on Exhibit A-6 as actual fees and expenses are incurred, but the SDR will seek to accomplish the closing within the closing budget amount, applying savings in connection with one subcontractor or service provider to address extra expenses as to a different subcontractor or service provider where necessary.

Final Statement of Expenses

22. Under § 443.015 of the Code, the SDR will submit a detailed final statement of the actual expenses incurred when the SDR files the verified application to terminate the estate. If the actual expenses differ from the amount reserved, the excess funds or the shortfall (as applicable) will be handled as described in this Application.

VII. DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Phase One: Assets Available for Distribution by Texas Select

23. As of June 30, 2024 there was \$65,178,399 in unrestricted cash in the receivership estate's accounts.

24. After reserving for the remaining administrative expenses through closing as described above and payment of June 2024 administrative expenses, sufficient funds remain to permit a 100% distribution by Texas Select to all classes of claims. This Application proposes a distribution of this cash such that all approved POC holders in Classes 1 through 9 receive 100% of the principal amount of the approved claim, plus interest as discussed below. Following completion

of the distribution to allowed claimants in Classes 1 through 10, substantial residual funds will remain in the estate.

25. After distribution of the assets of Texas Select to its creditors, its reserve funds and assets remaining will be transferred to Vesta Fire. The assets to be transferred to Vesta Fire include an approved POC number 5260288 for amounts owed under a reinsurance agreement in favor of Texas Select against Vesta Fire. Texas Select will assign the remaining amount owed under this POC to Vesta Fire, which will have the effect of removing this liability from the Vesta Fire statement of liabilities.

26. Vesta Fire provided the underwriters with the reserve funds to operate as a Lloyds Plan. Each underwriter signed a trust agreement that any return of those funds would be held in trust for the benefit of Vesta Fire. See Affidavit of Craig A. Koenig and Exhibit A-7 to that affidavit, which is incorporated by reference.

Plan for Payment of Interest as to Texas Select

27. Sufficient assets exist for the payment of interest to approved POC claimants above shareholder priority. Section 443.301(j) of the Code provides for priority Class 10 distribution to claimants for interest on allowed claims of Classes 1 through 9 if approved by the Court.

28. The SDR proposes to set the interest rate on allowed POCs at 6% per annum simple interest with interest on the unpaid portion of the allowed claim amount for approved POC holders in Classes 1 through 8, calculated on the unpaid portion of the allowed claim amount for the time from the later of the date of the initial order appointing the Receiver as Liquidator of Texas Select or the date the claim was liquidated through the earlier of the date of distribution or June 30, 2024.

29. The SDR proposes to pay interest on the Class 9 Texas Select surplus debenture owed to SIS at the rate provided in the surplus debenture for Texas Select, which is a variable rate of

LIBOR plus 2 points. The LIBOR [London Inter-Bank Offered Rate] rate is an interest rate average that was calculated from estimates submitted by leading London banks. The LIBOR rate was replaced by the SOFR [Secured Overnight Financing Rate]. The SDR proposes to use SOFR + 2 as the interest rate for the surplus debenture for that era when the LIBOR ceased to be used. The interest distribution plan for Texas Select shall be:

- (a) The SDR calculates that more than sufficient assets of Texas Select exist to pay interest claims;
 - (b) The SDR will retain assets after paying the interest on the claims to provide reserves to facilitate the wind-up of the receivership;
 - (c) The SDR will pay interest at 6% simple interest on the principal amount of each claim other than the surplus debenture from the date of the Liquidation Order (or the date the claim was liquidated, if later) through June 30, 2024. If a claim cannot be paid in whole or in part due to the inability to locate the claimant or to obtain any requested tax reporting information from the claimant, interest would only run to the date that the SDR first paid claims of a similar classification under § 443.301 of the Code. The SDR will also make the interest distribution as mentioned above on the surplus debenture.
 - (d) The distribution will be made after thirty days have elapsed following the date of the order approving this Application. The SDR projects that as to Texas Select, sufficient funds exist to permit the full distribution to the approved Class 10 claims;
 - (e) The proposed 6% is the legal rate in effect for contract claims which do not specify an interest rate. The LIBOR + 2 rate is the rate specified in the surplus debenture;
- and

- (f) No interest payments will be made to guaranty associations or to secured claimants.

Phase Two: Assets Available for Distribution by SIS

30. SIS will receive a distribution of principal and interest under a surplus debenture issued by Texas Select. The Texas Select distribution will permit SIS to make its final distribution of the principal due to claimants with approved POCs in Classes 1 through 8. After reserving for the remaining administrative expenses through closing as described above and payment of June 2024 administrative expenses, sufficient funds remain to permit a 100% percent distribution by SIS. This Application proposes a distribution of this cash such that all approved POC holders in Classes 1 through 8 receive 100% of the principal amount of the approved claim, plus interest as set forth below.

Plan of Interest for SIS

31. The plan of interest for SIS is simpler than that for Texas Select, because SIS has only one remaining creditor, Vesta Fire. The assets available will permit the payment of a portion of this interest but will fall short of the assets necessary to pay the full 6% interest to its single creditor, Vesta Fire. The plan is to pay the claim of Vesta Fire plus as much of the 6% interest as the assets of SIS permit it to pay.

Eligible Claimants

32. There are sufficient assets to pay the principal amount of all allowed claims in all classes of claims against Texas Select and SIS in full. Attached as Exhibit A-8 to the Affidavit of Craig A. Koenig, and incorporated by reference, are Distribution Schedules listing all claimants against Texas Select and SIS, respectively, to whom a distribution will be made. This exhibit identifies each claimant's name as shown on the POC (individuals names have been removed for their privacy), the amount approved by the SDR, the calculated interest approved, and the projected distribution.

Distribution Process

33. The Distribution Notice attached as Exhibit A-9 to the Affidavit of Craig A. Koenig (Distribution Notice), and incorporated by reference, will be mailed to Texas Select claimants with allowed claims, advising them of the proposed distribution. The Distribution Notice will be mailed to the address provided by the claimant in the POC, or any subsequent address provided by the claimant. After the Court approves this Application, distributions will be made by wire transfer, if feasible, or by mailing a check by first class mail to the address provided by the claimant. If a Distribution Notice is returned by the Post Office with an address correction, the SDR will send the distribution check to the corrected address. SIS's sole approved creditor is Vesta Fire, so no Distribution Notice is necessary for the SIS distribution.

Distributions on *De Minimis* Claims

34. Section 443.253(h) of the Code provides for the disallowance of claims for de minimis amounts, as determined by this Court. The SDR proposes to establish a distribution threshold of \$20, which is reasonable and necessary for administrative convenience. The SDR requests that this Court find that any distribution under the proposed threshold be considered de minimis and authorize the SDR to withhold the amount of any such distribution. Any such amounts that are withheld will be treated as general assets.

Residual Funds

35. The SDR requests permission, after distribution of the funds to Classes 1 through 10 allowed claimants, that the residual funds after payment of expenses be distributed to Vesta Fire. Further, the Court is requested to order that Vesta Fire, as the recipient of the reserve funds, bear any actual administrative expenses in excess of the estimated expenses.

VIII. UNCLAIMED FUNDS

Unclaimed Distributions

36. The SDR will maintain the receiverships' distribution account for a period not less than 90 days after distributions are issued, unless all distribution checks are already cashed sooner than 90 days after distributions are issued. This will provide a reasonable amount of time for claimants to receive and deposit their checks. The SDR will deliver any funds which are unclaimed, including prior unclaimed distributions, as of the closing of the account to the Commissioner as required by § 443.304(a) of the Code to be placed in a segregated unclaimed funds account.

37. The SDR anticipates that several addresses provided by the claimants may no longer be current. If a Distribution Notice is mailed to an address and returned as undeliverable, the SDR requests that this Court order that any distribution due to a claimant whose notice is returned as non-deliverable be treated as unclaimed without the need for the estate to incur the expense of mailing an undeliverable check. The SDR proposes that all distributions to such claimants be withheld from the mailing of the final distribution and be delivered to the Commissioner on closing of the account as described in this Application. In addition, to the extent that a claimant fails to return any requested tax reporting information to the SDR as requested, the SDR seeks approval to treat those funds attributable to interest as unclaimed property. The Court is requested to authorize the SDR the power, but not the duty, to use service providers, in its discretion, to locate allowed claimant addresses.

IX. ASSIGNMENTS AND TRANSFERS

Assignment of Non-Cash Assets

38. Section 443.154 of the Code authorizes the SDR to transfer, abandon, or otherwise dispose of or deal with any property of the insurer on terms and conditions that are fair and reasonable. Further, § 443.352 of the Code permits the Court to enter any orders in connection

with an application to terminate a receivership proceeding. Any assets subsequently received by Texas Select should be assigned to Vesta Fire, which holds the rights of the underwriters of Texas Select. Any assets subsequently received by SIS should also be transferred to Vesta Fire, since the assets available to pay creditors of SIS is insufficient to pay Vesta Fire all principal and interest due, and Vesta Fire holds the interest of the equity holders of SIS. A copy of the proposed assignment and list of the known unliquidated assets assigned to Vesta Fire is attached as Exhibit A-10 to the Affidavit of Craig A. Koenig and incorporated by reference.

X. RECORDS

Disposal of Records

39. This Court has previously granted four applications to destroy non-essential records, which were no longer required for the administration of this receivership. The SDR proposes to transfer any remaining records of Texas Select and SIS to Vesta Fire, except such records that the Commissioner may notify the SDR that the Commissioner seeks to retain after the termination of this proceeding. On Vesta Fire's closing, a further order regarding records destruction is likely. The SDR requests authority to dispose of such records under § 443.354(a) of the Code.

Records Transferred to Commissioner

40. Records that may be required by the Commissioner after the termination of this proceeding will be delivered to the Commissioner under § 443.354(b) of the Code and maintained in compliance with the Receiver's records retention policy for receivership records. The SDR requests that the Court authorize the Commissioner to retain or dispose of these records at the Commissioner's discretion.

XI. TAX RETURNS

41. Texas Select is an affiliate of Vesta Fire and is included in Vesta Fire's consolidated income tax returns through December 31, 2022. All 2023 and 2024 activity for Texas Select will

be included in the appropriate Vesta Fire tax returns. SIS filed stand-alone tax returns through December 31, 2022. The 2023 tax return will be filed no later than the extended due date of October 15, 2024. A short period 2024 return will be filed once the final accounting of all funds in the estate has been completed. The distribution from Texas Select to SIS may result in taxable income to SIS for the 2024 return. SIS will have the assets to file the appropriate return(s) and to pay any such taxes. The SDR will file a final tax return for SIS once the distributions have been completed.

XII. CERTIFICATION OF CLOSING ACTIVITIES

42. Before or when the SDR files an application to terminate the estate and be discharged, the SDR will file evidence for the filing of the SIS final tax return and a copy of the release from the federal government, together with the final accounting of all funds in the estate. Texas Select's taxes will be addressed in the Vesta Fire tax returns. The SDR entered into an agreement with the United States Department of Justice which has the effect of releasing certain potential super-priority claims of the United States.

XIII. CHARTER AND LICENSES

43. The SDR has determined that a sale of the charter and licenses of Texas Select is not feasible. The SDR will request that this Court dissolve the charter under § 443.153(e) of the Code on the termination of this proceeding.

XIV. NOTICE

Notice of Application

44. Under § 443.007(d) of the Code and the Supplemental Order of Reference, the SDR served this Application at least 14 days before the submission date of this Application on (i) parties that filed an appearance in this proceeding and (ii) other parties as determined by the SDR as shown on the Certificate of Service.

Distribution Notices

45. The Distribution Notice attached as Exhibit A-9 to the Affidavit of Craig A. Koenig will be mailed to the claimants with allowed claims at least 14 days before the submission date of the Application.

REQUEST FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, the SDR respectfully requests that this Court enter an Order:

1. Accepting the final financial statements;
2. Approving in all respects this Final Report of Claims and Application to Make Final Distribution, and admitting the exhibits into evidence;
3. Approving the estimated expenses through the closing of the receivership under § 443.015 of the Code and providing that Vesta Fire will be responsible for any expenses in excess of the estimate;
4. Authorizing the SDR to distribute the cash assets of the receiverships as described in the Application and authorizing the SDR to determine that any distribution under \$20 be disallowed as de minimus;
5. Approving the plan for Class 10 interest distributions, and for a Class 11 distribution of the assets of Texas Select after payment of all claims in Classes 1 through 10;
6. Authorizing the SDR to transfer to Vesta Fire any residual assets remaining after all distributions are made;
7. Authorizing the SDR to deliver all unclaimed funds to the Commissioner, and finding that any distribution, in whole or in part, to a claimant for whom the Distribution Notice was returned as undeliverable or the interest portion of a

distribution to a claimant that failed to return the requested tax information may be deemed as unclaimed for purposes of § 443.304 of the Code;

8. Determining that no further late claims can be accepted, because such claims would prejudice the orderly administration of the estate under § 443.251(b) of the Code;
9. Approving the closing budget;
10. Approving the handling of records described in the Application;
11. Approving use of a letter substantially similar to Exhibit A-9 to notify claimants;
12. Admitting Exhibits A-1 through A-10 into evidence;

and granting such further relief to which the SDR or Receiver may be entitled.



3. I have reviewed the foregoing Application and recommend the relief set forth in the Application be granted by the Court.”



(d) Repay to Grantor, without interest, any funds Trustee may receive from Vesta Lloyds Insurance Company upon Trustee's withdrawal for any reason as an Underwriter at Vesta Lloyds Insurance Company.

3. Trustee's Powers. Trustee shall have power to execute and deliver any instruments required to comply with the dispositive provisions, and with the provisions of resignation or removal of Trustee, and for power of amendment and revocation included in this Agreement, in addition to any conferred by law.

4. Liability of the Trustee. Once Trustee has delivered the above described funds to the Attorney-in-Fact for Vesta Lloyds Insurance Company as Trustee's contribution as Underwriter at that Lloyds, Trustee shall have no liability to Grantor for those or other funds, until such time as Trustee receives funds or acquires a right to receive funds arising out of Trustee's being an Underwriter at Vesta Lloyds Insurance Company. Trustee shall have no responsibility or liability to the Grantor for any acts or omissions of the Attorney-in-Fact.

5. Resignation or Removal of Trustee. Trustee may resign by written notice to Grantor. Trustee may be removed at any time by Grantor by written notice to Trustee. Until the accounts of Trustee are settled and Trustee discharged, he shall continue to have all powers and discretions granted to him hereunder or conferred by law. In case of

resignation or removal of Trustee, Grantor may by instrument signed and acknowledged appoint a successor Trustee, and such successor Trustee upon executing an acknowledged acceptance of the trusteeship, and upon the settlement of the accounts and the discharge of the prior Trustee, shall be vested without further action on the part of anyone with all the estate, title, powers, duties, immunities and discretions granted to his predecessor. The prior Trustee shall, however, execute and deliver such assignment or other instrument as may be deemed advisable.

6. Situs. This Agreement is performable in the State of Texas, and all questions pertaining to its validity, construction and administration shall be determined in accordance with the laws of that state.

7. Power of Amendment and Revocation. Grantor may from time to time by instruments signed, acknowledged and delivered to Trustee modify, amend or revoke in whole or in part this Agreement or the trusts hereby created. To the extent thus revoked Trustee shall deliver the principal of the trust to Grantor, upon receiving the proper receipt, and shall execute and deliver any instruments required to release all interests of Trustee in such property. No modification shall increase Trustee's obligations without his consent in writing.

8. Death or Disability of Trustee. If Trustee should die, or become unable for any reason to serve or continue to serve as Trustee, the President of the Grantor, or his successor in office, shall become substitute Trustee, as though Trustee had been removed by Grantor.

9. Contribution Unencumbered. This Agreement is made with the express understanding that the funds advanced to Trustee once contributed to the Attorney-in-

Fact of Vesta Lloyds Insurance Company will become the unencumbered property of Vesta Lloyds Insurance Company, to constitute part of its guaranty fund and surplus within the contemplation of Chapter 18 of the Texas Insurance Code of 1951, as amended, to be allocated between guaranty fund and surplus as determined by the Attorney-in-Fact of Vesta Lloyds Insurance Company.

ORDER APPROVING FINAL REPORT OF CLAIMS AND GRANTING APPLICATION TO MAKE FINAL DISTRIBUTION FOR TEXAS SELECT LLOYDS INSURANCE COMPANY AND SELECT INSURANCE SERVICES, INC.

On this date, the Court considered the *Final Report of Claims and Application to Make Final Distribution for Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company and Select Insurance Services, Inc.* (Application) filed by Prime Tempus, Inc., Special Deputy Receiver (SDR) of Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation (Vesta Fire), Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company (Texas Select) and Select Insurance Services, Inc. (SIS).

The Application was submitted to the Special Master appointed in this cause (Master) under the Supplemental Order of Reference to Master entered on November 8, 2006, which provides that motions filed under Texas Insurance Code §§ 443.258 and 443.352 are referred to the Master. The Master issued a report under Rule 171 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, finding and recommending as follows:

1. Notice of the Application was provided under Texas Insurance Code § 443.007(d);
2. No objections to the Application were filed;
3. The Court has jurisdiction over the Application and the parties; and
4. The Application should be granted in all respects.

Having considered the pleadings, the evidence submitted, and the recommendation of the Master, the Court accepts the Master's report, and grants the Application.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. The Application is GRANTED in all respects, including but not limited to the closing budget, the interest rate plan proposed by the SDR, the distribution of assets by Texas Select and then by SIS to claimants and to Vesta Fire, and the transfer of non-cash assets to Vesta Fire. The Court admits into evidence the Affidavit of Craig A. Koenig and Exhibits A-1 through A-10 to that Affidavit;

2. The final financial statements are approved;

3. The estimated administrative expenses through the closing of the receivership under Texas Insurance Code § 443.015 are approved, including but not limited to the potential deduction of additional expenses from the distribution to Vesta Fire;

4. The SDR is authorized to take the steps and incur reasonable expenses to distribute the cash assets of the receiverships and the non-cash assets of the receivership as described in the Application. The SDR is authorized to disallow as de minimus claims for less than \$20;

5. The SDR may transfer to Vesta Fire all residual assets, including accounts receivable, of Texas Select and of SIS remaining after all distributions are made other than any funds required for closing expenses. The SDR may assign any future recoveries as to such assets to Vesta Fire;

6. The SDR is authorized to deliver all unclaimed funds to the Commissioner, and the Court finds that any distribution to a claimant for whom the Distribution Notice was returned as undeliverable, or for whom a W-9 was requested but not returned, will be deemed as unclaimed

for purposes of Texas Insurance Code §443.304. The Court approves the use of a letter substantially similar to Exhibit A-9 to notify claimants;

7. The SDR is authorized to execute any documents for tax filings in connection with Texas Select and SIS that the SDR deems necessary or appropriate;

8. The SDR's report of claims under Texas Insurance Code § 443.258 is approved. No further late claims will be accepted because those late claims would prejudice the administration of the estate;

9. The SDR is authorized to deliver all records received or created during receivership to the SDR of Vesta Fire or to the Commissioner and to dispose of any records or copies of such records as are not needed by the Commissioner or the SDR of Vesta Fire; and

10. This order constitutes a final judgment fully resolving all issues relating to the Application.
