**NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF VERIFIED FINAL ACCOUNTING AND APPLICATION TO TERMINATE RECEIVERSHIP AND DISCHARGE RECEIVER AND SPECIAL DEPUTY RECEIVER AS TO TEXAS SELECT LLOYDS INSURANCE COMPANY AND SELECT INSURANCE SERVICES, INC. ONLY**

In accordance with the Supplemental Order of Reference to Master ("Order of Reference") entered in this cause, the Special Deputy Receiver's Verified Final Accounting and Application to Terminate Receivership and Discharge Receiver and Special Deputy Receiver as to Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company and Select Insurance Services, Inc. only, is set for submission before the Special Master, Tom Collins, ("Master") on Monday, June 30, 2025. Pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 443.007 (e) and TEX. R. CIV. P. 171, the Order of Reference has established the following rules:

1. The Master may consider the Application by written submission or oral hearing.
2. If no objection is filed in compliance with the Order of Reference, the Master may consider the Application without a hearing, and the Court may enter the order recommended by the Master upon its submission to the Court. A party waives any right to object to the recommendation of the Master if the party does not file an objection in compliance with the Order of Reference.

An objecting party must expeditiously coordinate with the Applicant's counsel and with the Master's docket clerk at (512) 676-6915 to request a hearing, unless the Master determines that a hearing is not necessary. If a hearing is granted, the objecting party must send a Notice of Oral Hearing to the Applicant's counsel and all parties listed on the Certificate of Service.
7. Any Acknowledgment of Notice and Waiver by a party in interest should be filed with the Court at least three (3) calendar days before the submission or hearing date.

AS TO TEXAS SELECT LLOYDS INSURANCE COMPANY AND SELECT  
INSURANCE SERVICES, INC. ONLY**

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Prime Tempus, Inc., Special Deputy Receiver (SDR) of Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation (Vesta Fire), Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company (Texas Select), and Select Insurance Services, Inc. (Select Insurance) files its Verified Final Accounting and Application to Terminate Receivership and Discharge Receiver and Special Deputy Receiver as to Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company and Select Insurance Services, Inc. only.

**I. RELIEF REQUESTED**

1. On November 25, 2024, this Court entered its Order Approving Final Report of Claims and Granting Application to Make Final Distribution for Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company and Select Insurance Services, Inc. (Distribution Order). The SDR has completed the distribution of assets under the Distribution Order and submits this final accounting. The SDR requests that the Court terminate this proceeding, discharge the Texas Commissioner of Insurance (Commissioner) as Receiver of Texas Select and Select Insurance, and discharge the SDR. This Application will not affect the receivership proceedings of Vesta Fire, which remain pending.

## II. AUTHORITY

2. The SDR is authorized to file this Application under § 443.352 of the Texas Insurance Code (Code). The subject matter of this Application has been referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding under the *Order of Reference to Master* entered on June 28, 2006 and the Supplemental Order of Reference to Master entered on November 8, 2006.

## III. BACKGROUND

### Company History

3. Texas Select is a Lloyds plan insurer. Select Insurance is its attorney-in-fact. Texas Select was writing homeowner policies at the time it was placed in receivership.

### Institution of Receivership Proceeding

4. Texas Select and Select Insurance were placed in rehabilitation on June 28, 2006 under the *Agreed Order Appointing Rehabilitator and Permanent Injunction*. Texas Select and Select Insurance were placed into liquidation on August 1, 2006, under this Court's *Order Appointing Liquidator and Permanent Injunction* (Liquidation Order).

### Appointment of Receivers

5. The Commissioner was appointed Receiver on June 28, 2006, under the Insurer Receivership Act § 21A.151, now § 443.151 of the Code. Commissioner Cassie Brown is currently Receiver of Texas Select and Select Insurance and all predecessors have been discharged as Receiver by operation of law.

### Appointment of Special Deputy Receiver

6. Prime Tempus, Inc. was appointed Special Deputy Receiver of Texas Select and Select Insurance on or about July 11, 2006.

Referral to Master

7. On November 8, 2006, this Court entered a Supplemental Order of Reference to Master and referred this matter to Tom Collins as Master.

Guaranty Associations Triggered

8. The Liquidation Order triggered the Texas Property and Casualty Insurance Guaranty Association. That guaranty association became obligated to pay covered policyholder claims of Texas Select under its governing statutes.

9. The SDR made the distributions approved by the Court in its Distribution Order, except those distributions for which the SDR could not make a distribution due to an inaccurate address, as well as one Proof of Claim that was withdrawn.

**IV. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

10. The following final financial statements are attached to this Application as to Texas Select and as to Select Insurance

- a. Statement of Net Assets, Exhibit A-1;
- b. Statement of Net Liabilities, Exhibit A-2; and
- c. Sources and Uses of Cash, Exhibit A-3.

**V. EXPENSES**

11. The Distribution Order approved a closing budget for the payment of administrative expenses in the amount of \$99,900 through the termination of the receivership. As of March 31, 2025, closing expenses totaling \$74,820 have been paid. The remaining significant closing activity is the retention of records for transfer to the Commissioner. Since this activity is being completed in conjunction with record retention activities in Vesta Fire and other subsidiary receiverships, the existence of remaining unspent budgeted closing expenses of approximately \$25,080 and the

transfer of remaining residual assets in Texas Select and Select Insurance to Vesta Fire, the Court is requested to approve the future use of Vesta Fire assets to complete the remaining closing activities associated with Texas Select and Select Insurance. Attached as Exhibit A-4 is the final statement of expenses submitted under § 443.015 of the Code, which reflects the expenses for completion of the identified closing budget items. The Court is requested to order that the distribution of residual assets to Vesta Fire be made net of these excess expenses.

## **VI. DISTRIBUTION**

12. The SDR made a final report of claims, which this Court approved in its Distribution Order. The SDR issued distributions in the form of wire transfers and checks to those creditors for whom distribution was approved in the Distribution Order. The distribution was sufficient to pay creditors in priority classes 1 through 10 in full, and to permit the remaining reserve assets to be transferred to Vesta Fire as assignee of the underwriters. The total of all interim and final distributions was \$171,126,697.

## **VII. UNCLAIMED FUNDS**

13. There is a total of \$275,612.75 representing unclaimed funds for which:

- Checks were issued but not cashed; or
- Payments could not be issued due to the identified payees' failure to respond to multiple requests for payment information; or
- Premium returns prior to the final distributions that were returned or remained outstanding.

Notices to payees and the checks were sent in envelopes that contained the SDR's mailing address as a return address. The SDR monitored the mail for returned envelopes. During the liquidation, the SDR team expended diligent effort to locate the payees. In some cases, funds remained

unclaimed. The list of unclaimed distributions including the amount of the distribution, the claim number and the date is submitted as Exhibit A-5. As the payees include individuals, the names of the payees are redacted. The SDR has delivered an unredacted version of Exhibit A-5 to the Receiver. The SDR has delivered unclaimed funds in the SDR's possession to the Receiver. Section 443.304 of the Code provides that these funds will be placed in a segregated unclaimed funds account held by the Commissioner.

### **VIII. FEDERAL INCOME TAX RETURNS**

14. Texas Select is an affiliate of Vesta Fire and is included in Vesta Fire's consolidated income tax returns through December 31, 2023. The 2024 and 2025 activity for Texas Select will be included in the appropriate year's Vesta Fire consolidated return. Select Insurance filed stand-alone tax returns as to tax years from 2015 through December 31, 2024. A short-year 2025 tax (final) return for Select Insurance will be filed within 25 days of the entry of the requested order. A Request for Prompt Assessment has been filed with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) for Select Insurance's tax years 2022, 2023, and 2024 and a separate request will be filed after Select Insurance's 2025 return has been filed. The 2024 Select Insurance tax return reflects no tax due and no tax is anticipated on the final 2025 return. In the event the Select Insurance's 2024 or 2025 tax returns are examined by the IRS and tax is assessed, the obligation for payment will be paid by Vesta Fire.

### **IX. CHARTER**

15. Under § 443.153 of the Code, the SDR requests dissolution of the charter of Texas Select and Select Insurance. The SDR requests that the dissolution of Texas Select and Select Insurance be deemed complete by operation of law upon discharge of the Receiver.

## **X. RECORDS**

16. The Distribution Order authorized the SDR to transfer to Vesta Fire the remaining records in Receivership other than those records that the Commissioner requested be transferred to the Commissioner. The SDR requests that this Court authorize the Commissioner and Vesta Fire to dispose of Texas Select and Select Insurance records transferred to each of them at their discretion. The SDR requests that the Court authorize the guaranty association holding claim records pertaining to Texas Select and Select Insurance to destroy their claims records.

## **XI. TERMINATION AND DISCHARGE AS TO TEXAS SELECT AND SELECT INSURANCE ONLY**

17. The SDR requests that this Court issue an order terminating the receivership estate and discharging the Receiver and the SDR as to Texas Select and Select Insurance only. This Application deals with the wind-up and closing of Texas Select and Select Insurance. The SDR request that the order permits the Commissioner to take reasonably necessary steps to complete the closing and termination in this Application, including the transfer of any further assets belonging to Texas Select and Select Insurance collected by the Commissioner after termination to Vesta Fire, without the need for re-opening Texas Select or Select Insurance.

## **XII. OFFER OF PROOF**

18. The Affidavit and Verification of Craig A. Koenig is filed with this Application and incorporated into this Application by reference for all purposes. This Affidavit authenticates Exhibits A-1 through A-5. The Court is requested to admit the Affidavit and Verification of Craig A. Koenig and its exhibits into evidence.

WHEREFORE, the SDR prays that this Court grant this Application and enter an order:

- a) Granting the Application in all respects;

- b) Admitting the Affidavit and Verification of Craig A. Koenig and its exhibits into evidence;
- c) Approving the transfer of the unclaimed distributions shown on Exhibit A-5 to the Commissioner;
- d) Authorizing the Commissioner and Vesta Fire to destroy the remaining records at the Commissioner's or Vesta Fire's discretion and authorizing the Guaranty Association holding claim records pertaining to Texas Select and Select Insurance to destroy these claims records;
- e) Authorizing the Commissioner and the SDR to take reasonably necessary steps to complete the closing and termination in this Application, including the transfer of any further assets belonging to Texas Select and Select Insurance collected by the Commissioner after termination to Vesta Fire, without the need for re-opening Texas Select or Select Insurance under § 443.253 of the Code;
- f) Dissolving the corporate charters of Texas Select and Select Insurance;
- g) Finding that Vesta Fire will bear any expenses, including any expenses for document retention related activities greater than the closing budget previously approved by the Court and the payment of any future taxes required by the IRS;
- h) Discharging the Receiver and the SDR;
- i) Terminating this proceeding;
- j) Authorizing the SDR to sign the final tax returns and other closing documents; and

k) Granting the Receiver and the SDR other relief to which they may be entitled.

work I rely in attesting to those exhibits.



**ORDER APPROVING VERIFIED FINAL ACCOUNTING AND APPLICATION TO TERMINATE RECEIVERSHIP AND DISCHARGE RECEIVER AND SPECIAL DEPUTY RECEIVER AS TO TEXAS SELECT LLOYDS INSURANCE COMPANY AND SELECT INSURANCE SERVICES, INC. ONLY**

On this date, the Court considered the Verified Final Accounting and Application to Terminate Receivership and Discharge Receiver and Special Deputy Receiver as to Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company and Select Insurance Services, Inc. only (Application) filed by Prime Tempus, Inc., Special Deputy Receiver (SDR) of Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company (Texas Select) and of Select Insurance Services, Inc. (Select Insurance).

The Application requests an order under Texas Insurance Code §§ 443.153, 443.352, and 443.354, which terminates the receivership, discharges the Receiver and the SDR, approves certain asset transfers, dissolves the charters of Texas Select and Select Insurance, and other related relief. The Application was submitted to the Special Master appointed in this cause (Master) under the Supplemental Order of Reference to Master entered on November 8, 2006, which provides that motions filed under Texas Insurance Code §§ 443.258 and 443.352 are referred to the Master. The Master issued a report under Rule 171 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, finding and recommending as follows:

1. Notice of the Application was provided under Texas Insurance Code § 443.007(d);

2. No objections to the Application were filed;
3. The Court has jurisdiction over the Application and the parties; and
4. The Application should be granted in all respects.

Having considered the pleadings, the evidence submitted, and the recommendation of the Master, the Court accepts the Master's report and grants the Application.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. The Application is granted in all respects;
2. The Court admits into evidence the Affidavit and Verification of Craig A. Koenig and Exhibits A-1 through A-5 to that Affidavit and Verification;
3. The transfer of unclaimed distributions to the Commissioner is approved.
4. The Commissioner may take reasonably necessary steps to complete the closing and termination in this application, including the transfer of any further assets belonging to Texas Select and Select Insurance collected by the Commissioner after termination to Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation, without the need for re-opening Texas Select and Select Insurance under § 443.253 of the Code;
5. The Commissioner or Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation may destroy the remaining records at the Commissioner's or Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation's discretion. The Guaranty Association may destroy claims records of Texas Select and Select Insurance in its possession.
6. This order dissolves the corporate charter of Texas Select and Select Insurance;
7. The Receiver and the SDR are discharged;

8. Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation will bear any expenses greater than the closing budget previously approved by this Court, including, without limitation, record retention-related activities as well as the payment of any taxes required by the IRS;
9. This proceeding is terminated;
10. The SDR may sign any final tax documents and closing documents; and
11. This order constitutes a final judgment fully resolving all issues relating to the Application as to Texas Select and Select Insurance.
