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**THE COMMISSIONER OF THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE'S  
MOTION TO DECLARE FUNDS ABANDONED,  
APPROVE NOTICE, AND SET HEARING**

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The Commissioner of the Texas Department of Insurance (Commissioner) files this Motion to Declare Funds Abandoned, Approve Notice, and Set Hearing, pursuant to Texas Insurance Code section 443.304, and respectfully shows the Court as follows:

**RELIEF REQUESTED**

1. This case was initially filed as a receivership proceeding under Texas Insurance Code Article 21.28. Effective September 1, 2005, pending receiverships brought under Texas Insurance Code Article 21.28 became governed by Texas Insurance Code Article 21A, later redesignated as Texas Insurance Code Chapter 443.
2. The receivership proceeding closed August 2, 2010, after a final distribution of receivership estate funds. Funds totaling \$294,992.73 distributed from the receivership were unclaimed as ordered by the Court's *Order Approving Amended Final Report and Application to Distribute Assets*. The Commissioner subsequently distributed \$214,097.35 from the unclaimed funds and unclaimed funds totaling \$80,895.38 (Unclaimed Funds) remain unclaimed as of the date of the filing of this Motion.

3. The Commissioner requests the Court direct the notice of the Motion, set the Motion for a hearing, and upon hearing, declare that the Unclaimed Funds have been abandoned and order the funds and the interest earned on those funds be disbursed under Texas Insurance Code section 443.304(b)(1) to the general receivership expense account established by the Commissioner.

### **BACKGROUND**

4. The Court ordered Comprehensive Health Services of Texas, Inc. into liquidation in this cause and appointed the Commissioner of Insurance as Temporary Receiver, who appointed Harry L. Sivley as Special Deputy Receiver (SDR). Thereafter, the Court appointed the Commissioner as Permanent Receiver in this cause.

5. On August 18, 2009, the SDR filed the *Amended Final Report and Application to Distribute Assets* (Distribution Application), seeking authority to distribute the remaining receivership funds and proposed that any distribution to claimants that is returned as undeliverable or otherwise unpaid by claimants be treated as unclaimed and remitted to the Commissioner as provided by Texas Insurance Code section 443.304. The Distribution Application is attached as **Exhibit 1**.

6. On August 31, 2009, this Court granted all relief sought in the Distribution Application in its *Order Approving Amended Final Report and Application to Distribute Assets* (Distribution Order), attached as **Exhibit 2**.

7. On July 8, 2010, the SDR filed a *Final Accounting and Application to Terminate Receivership and Discharge Receiver and Special Deputy Receiver* (Final Accounting). The Final Accounting reported the SDR withheld unclaimed funds from the final distribution, identified in Exhibit C to the Final Accounting. As approved by the Distribution Order, the SDR reported it

remitted the unclaimed funds to the Commissioner as provided by Texas Insurance Code section 443.304. The SDR's Final Accounting is attached as **Exhibit 3**.

8. This Court approved the Final Accounting on August 2, 2010, in its *Order Approving Final Accounting and Application to Terminate Receivership and Discharge Receiver and Special Deputy Receiver (Closing Order)*, attached as **Exhibit 4**.

9. In accordance with Texas Insurance Code section 443.304, the SDR remitted unclaimed funds totaling \$294,992.73 to the Commissioner. The Commissioner subsequently distributed \$214,061.58 to persons entitled to those funds and the remaining funds were placed in a segregated unclaimed funds account held by the Commissioner on or about June 30, 2012. The persons entitled to these unclaimed funds were permitted to claim their funds as required by Texas Insurance Code section 443.304(a) for a period of two years from the date of the termination of the proceedings, during which time the Commissioner remitted unclaimed funds totaling \$35.77 to a person entitled to those funds. The remaining funds totaling \$80,895.38 were never claimed by persons entitled to those funds, and those funds remain in the segregated unclaimed funds account held by the Commissioner. The Unclaimed Funds earned interest, which has also been retained in the segregated unclaimed funds account, as provided by Texas Insurance Code section 443.304.

10. Texas Insurance Code section 443.304 provides for the abandonment of unclaimed funds from closed receiverships and governs the disposition of those funds. The Commissioner requests this Court declare that the Unclaimed Funds and the interest earned on those funds are abandoned and order the abandoned funds deposited in the general receivership expense account established by the Commissioner as provided by Texas Insurance Code section 443.304(b)(1).

## AUTHORITY AND EVIDENCE

11. Under Texas Insurance Code section 443.304, the Unclaimed Funds may be declared abandoned upon proof to the satisfaction of this Court that:

- (1) The funds were unclaimed after the final distribution;
- (2) The funds were placed in a segregated unclaimed funds account held by the Commissioner as required by Texas Insurance Code section 443.304(a);
- (3) The funds remain unclaimed in that segregated unclaimed funds account after two years from the date of termination of the proceeding;
- (4) The name of the insurer, the names and last known addresses of the persons entitled to the unclaimed funds, if known, and the amount of the funds are identified in this Motion and attached as **Exhibit 5**; and
- (5) Notice of this Motion will be given as directed by the Court in accordance with Texas Insurance Code section 443.304(b).

12. Documents reflecting that the Unclaimed Funds were placed in a segregated unclaimed funds account held by the Commissioner, and the Unclaimed Funds remaining in that segregated unclaimed funds account are attached as **Exhibit 6**. This exhibit, which has been certified as a government record, demonstrates the following:

- (1) The SDR's Final Accounting identified all unclaimed funds and funds which could not be distributed including the Unclaimed Funds. The Closing Order approved the Final Accounting, which confirmed the funds were unclaimed as provided by Texas Insurance Code section 443.304 and is a final judgment in this proceeding with respect to the distribution.

(2) The SDR remitted \$294,992.73 in unclaimed funds to the Commissioner and, after subsequent distributions totaling \$214,061.58, the remaining Unclaimed Funds totaling \$80,931.15 were placed in a segregated unclaimed funds account held by the Commissioner on June 30, 2012, from which a distribution of \$35.77 was made. The remaining funds in the segregated unclaimed funds account total \$80,895.38 plus accrued interest.

13. Texas Insurance Code section 443.304(b) provides that upon this Court's finding of the facts set out in subsections 11(1)-(5) above, the Court shall order the Unclaimed Funds and the interest on those funds abandoned to be disbursed and they may be deposited into the general receivership expense account established by the Commissioner.

#### **NOTICE AND REQUEST FOR HEARING**

14. Texas Insurance Code section 443.304(b) provides that notice of this Motion shall be given as directed by this Court. TDI requests that the Court order publication at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the county where this Motion is filed.

15. The proposed form of the notice by publication is attached as **Exhibit 7**. The Commissioner requests this Court approve and direct the form of notice and set this Motion for hearing.

#### **CONCLUSION AND PRAYER**

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Commissioner respectfully requests that this Court:

1. Direct the form of the Notice for this Motion as attached as **Exhibit 7**;
2. Set this Motion for a hearing;

3. Upon hearing the Motion, order that the Unclaimed Funds are abandoned, and that the abandoned Unclaimed Funds and the past and future interest earned on the funds are to be deposited in the general receivership expense account established by the Commissioner; and
4. Grant the Commissioner such further relief to which she may be entitled.

**AMENDED FINAL REPORT AND APPLICATION TO DISTRIBUTE ASSETS**

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

COMES NOW Applicant Harry L. Sivley, Special Deputy Receiver (the “SDR”) under contract to Mike Geeslin, Receiver of Comprehensive Health Services of Texas, Inc., d/b/a Wellchoice, In Receivership (the “Receivership”), and files this Amended Final Report And Application To Distribute Assets (the “Amended Final Report and Application”) and in support thereof would respectfully show the Court as follows:

**I.  
BACKGROUND**

1 1 Comprehensive Health Services of Texas, Inc., d/b/a WellChoice, was a Texas health maintenance organization that provided health care benefits to approximately 17,000 Texas residents

1 2 This proceeding was initiated on February 3, 1999, pursuant to Tex Ins Code (the “Code”) Articles 21.28 and 21.28-A. On February 3, 1999, this Court entered a Temporary Restraining Order and Order Appointing Temporary Receiver, appointing the Commissioner of Insurance (the “Commissioner”) as Temporary Receiver. Harry L. Sivley was appointed SDR effective May 11, 1999, and filed his oath on May 12, 1999. Thereafter, on August 30, 1999, the Court entered a Permanent Injunction and Order Appointing Permanent Receiver, appointing the Commissioner as Permanent Receiver in this cause

1.3. Effective September 1, 2005 this proceeding became governed by the Insurer Receivership Act, codified as Chapter 443 of the Code

1.4. The SDR is authorized to file this Application pursuant to Chapter 443 of the Code Under Code §443.154(a), the SDR has all the powers of the Receiver, unless specifically limited by the Receiver.

1.5. The subject matter of this Application has been referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding in accordance with the Amended Order of Reference to Master entered by this Court on November 3, 2005 (“Order of Reference”).

## **II. PROPERTY RECEIVED**

2.1. The property received by the Receivership which has come into the possession of the SDR to date of this Application is \$2,723,471, as more particularly reflected on Line 134 of the Sources and Uses of Cash Statement attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference.

2.2. There are no unliquidated assets of the Receivership Estate.

## **III. EXPENDITURES**

3.1. The fees, expenses, and other payments which have been made by the Receivership to date of this Application are in the amount of \$1,806,408, as more particularly reflected on Line 139 of the Sources and Uses of Cash Statement attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference. Since his appointment, the SDR has filed periodic Statements of Expenses pursuant to Article 21 28, § 12(b) of the Code for fees and expenses through August 31, 2005. These Statements have been duly approved pursuant to Article 21 28, § 12(b) of the Code. On October 31, 2005, this Court approved the terms of compensation of the SDR and its contractors pursuant to §21A.015 of

the Code.

#### **IV. PROPERTY REMAINING**

4.1. The property of the Receivership remaining in the hands of the SDR is in the amount of \$2,383,048, consisting solely of liquid assets, as reflected on Lines 151 & 153 of the Sources and Uses of Cash Statement attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference

#### **V. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

5.1. The Statement of Net Assets and the Statement of Liabilities and Equity for the Receivership, reflecting the financial condition of the Receivership estate as of June 30, 2009; and the consolidated Cash Sources and Uses Statement, listing all funds received and disbursed from the date of Receivership to date of this Application; are submitted in accordance with Code §443.016, and are attached as Exhibits A, B, and C, and incorporated herein by reference.

#### **VI. CLOSING EXPENSES**

6.1. The SDR estimates that \$26,382 will be needed to pay expenses of the Receivership anticipated to be incurred from the date of this Application until the filing of the Final Accounting and Application to Close Receivership and Discharge Receiver; and the SDR requests that this amount be set aside for payment of the closing expenses. A detailed Estimate of Estate Closing Expenses is attached hereto as Exhibit D, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. If any portion of these expenses is unused, the SDR requests that such unapplied funds be transferred to the Receiver to be used as described below. The SDR will submit a final statement of the actual expenses incurred in the Final Accounting

6.2. The SDR anticipates that expenses will be incurred by the Receiver or the Texas Department of Insurance after the distribution of assets for various activities related to the Receivership, such as responding to inquiries from claimants or the general public. As it is not possible to estimate the cost of these activities with any reasonable certainty, the SDR is not reserving any assets from the distribution to pay for these activities. As is further described in Paragraphs 10.5 - 10.6, any such expenses will be payable from residual assets remaining after the distribution.

## VII. CLAIMS

7.1. On or about October 26, 1999, the Court entered its Order Fixing Liability Of The Receivership Estate and Setting Claim Filing Deadline in this cause. The claim filing deadline was February 15, 2000; and Proofs of claim were mailed to the known claimants as required by the aforementioned Order of this Court.

7.2. In accordance with such Order Fixing Liability Of The Receivership Estate and Setting Claim Filing Deadline, the SDR provided notice of the claim filing deadline to all persons who may have had claims as shown by the Receivership's books and records.

7.3. On or about February 1, 2000, this Court entered an Order Granting Application for Authorization to Utilize Alternative Claims Adjudication Procedures. All proofs of claim against the Receivership estate have been adjudicated with respect to their classification and amount and pursuant to Code Article 21.28, §3(h) and such Order. The appeal periods for proofs of claim that were denied by the SDR have expired, and no appeals were filed with respect to any claims. No late claims have been submitted to this Court for approval under either Code Article 21.28, §3(b), or Code §443.251(b). A listing of all claims filed and a description of the SDR's action concerning each claim is attached as Exhibit E, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

All claims were initially classified under Code Article 21.28, §8, in effect as of the date of

commencement of this Receivership. Effective September 1, 2005, the distribution of assets became governed by Code §443 301. As a result, the priorities of certain claims were reclassified. As the revised classification did not affect distributions to any claimants, it was not necessary to notify claimants of the change in classification.

### **VIII. TAXES**

8.1 The SDR has filed income tax returns with the Internal Revenue Service for the years 1999-2008. The SDR anticipates filing the federal tax return after the filing of the Amended Final Report and Application. The SDR requests this Court to authorize him to sign the federal tax return, and any other supporting documents necessary to file the return. It is estimated that \$2,000.00 of taxes may be owed to the Internal Revenue Service.

### **IX. LITIGATION**

9.1 There are no lawsuits pending in which the Receiver or SDR is a named party.

### **X. PROPOSED DISTRIBUTION OF PROPERTY REMAINING**

10.1 As of the date of this Amended Final Report and Application, there was \$2,383,048 in cash in the Receivership estate's accounts. After reserving for the remaining administrative expenses through closing of the Receivership as described above, \$2,325,816 will be available for distribution.

10.2 The SDR proposes to distribute the property of the Receivership remaining in the hands of the SDR as reflected on Exhibit F, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The projected distribution is an approximate figure based on current financial data, and the actual distribution may vary from this projection.

10.3 The notice attached as Exhibit G (the “Distribution Notice”) will be mailed to all claimants with approved claims, advising them of the proposed distribution. The Distribution Notice will be mailed to the address provided by the claimant in the POC, or any subsequent address provided by the claimant. Upon approval of this Application by the Court, distributions will be made by wire transfer or by mailing a check by first class mail to the address provided by the claimant. In the event that a Distribution Notice is returned by the Post Office with an address correction, the SDR will send the distribution check to the corrected address. In the event a distribution is returned undeliverable, the SDR therefore requests that this Court enter an order providing any distribution to such claimant that is returned as undeliverable should be treated as unclaimed and be delivered to the Commissioner upon closing of the Receivership as provided below.

10.4 The SDR will maintain the Receivership’s distribution account for a period of ninety (90) days, which will provide a reasonable amount of time for claimants to receive and deposit their checks. The checks will expire ninety (90) days after date of issuance. The SDR will deliver any funds that are unclaimed as of the closing of the account to the Commissioner as required by Code §443.304(a).

10.5 It is possible that there may be additional funds in the Receivership account after the distribution (hereinafter “Residual Funds”). Such funds may result from interest on the Receivership account, excess reserves for closing expenses, or the collection of assets after the distribution has commenced. Such funds will be handled as described herein.

10.6 Code §443.352 provides this Court may issue an order to transfer funds remaining after the final distribution that cannot be economically distributed. In the event that there are any funds remaining after the final distribution, and it is not economically feasible to distribute such funds, the SDR requests that such funds be transferred to the Commissioner for deposit in an account established under Code §443.304(c). Such funds will be available to pay any expenses exceeding the

expense reserve, or expenses incurred for activities after the closing of the Receivership, such as responding to inquiries and handling unclaimed funds.

## **XI. ASSIGNMENT OF UNKNOWN ASSETS**

11.1 Code § 443.154 authorizes the SDR to transfer, abandon, or otherwise dispose of or deal with any property of the insurer upon terms and conditions that are fair and reasonable. Further, Code §443.352 permits the Court to enter any orders in connection with an application to terminate a Receivership proceeding. There are presently no known cash or non-cash assets of the Receivership that are not reflected in this Amended Final Report and Application; however, the SDR proposes to assign to the Commissioner any and all other cash and non-cash assets of the Receivership in the event that any such assets should be discovered in the future. In the event that any assigned assets are collected and liquidated, and such amount is sufficient to justify a distribution, this proceeding may be reopened under Code §443.353. If such amount cannot be distributed economically, the SDR requests that any such funds be deposited in accordance with Code §443.304(c).

## **XII. RECORDS RETENTION AND DESTRUCTION**

12.1 The SDR has identified certain records that are no longer necessary for the administration of the Receivership; nor do such records need to be preserved after closure. The storage of these obsolete records is an additional and unnecessary expense to the Receivership. An itemized inventory of the records that are no longer necessary to be maintained is attached hereto as Exhibit H. The SDR hereby requests authority to destroy such records in accordance with Code §443.354(a).

12.2 The SDR estimates that there will be certain records that should be retained and stored after closing of the Receivership. The SDR requests that this Court authorize the SDR to deliver such records to the Commissioner of Insurance to retain or dispose of these records at his

discretion pursuant to Code §443.354(b)

**XIII.  
NOTICE**

13.1 In compliance with Code §443.007(d), and the Rules adopted by the Master in the Order of Reference under Tex. R. Civ. P. 171, this Amended Final Report and Application has been served on the service list as shown on the Certificate of Service 14 days prior to the submission date of the Application.

**XIV.  
PRAYER**

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the SDR respectfully requests that this Court enter an Order:


- A. Approving this Amended Final Report and Application to Distribute Assets;
- B. Authorizing the SDR to reserve \$26,382 from the distribution of the Estate to be used to pay costs administrative costs to be incurred until the closing of the Receivership;
- C. Authorizing the SDR to timely file the federal income tax return for 2009, and any documents after the filing of the Final Accounting;
- D. Authorizing the SDR to distribute the cash assets of the estate as proposed herein;
- E. Finding that any payment to a claimant whose distribution is returned as undeliverable be deemed as unclaimed;
- F. Authorizing the SDR to maintain the Receivership accounts for up to ninety (90) days or less after approval of the Amended Final Report and Application to Distribute Assets and deliver all unclaimed funds to the Commissioner;
- G. Authorizing the transfer of any residual funds accumulated after the distribution of

assets to the Commissioner;

- H. Authorizing the destruction of all non-essential Receivership records;
- I. Authorizing the delivery of all remaining records to the Commissioner, to maintain, transfer, or dispose of any other records, at his discretion;
- J. Authorizing the SDR to assign to the Commissioner any and all presently unknown cash and non-cash assets of the Receivership in the event that any such assets should be discovered in the future;
- K. Authorizing the SDR to submit to the Court a final itemized and verified expense report; and
- L. Authorizing the SDR to submit to the Court after the distribution is made, a Final Accounting and an order releasing and discharging the SDR and the Receiver.


APPLICANT'S NOTICE OF SUBMISSION

Pursuant to the Order of reference to Master entered by the District Court in this cause, the Amended Final Report and Application to Distribute Assets, is hereby set for written submission before the Special Master, Tom Collins, on Monday, August 31, 2009

The Special Master has asked that the following rules be provided you:

1. Any objection must be filed with the Travis County District Clerk at least three (3) calendar days before the submission date.
2. A copy of any objection shall be served by such date on:
  - (a) The Special Master's Docket Clerk, Ms Jean Sustaita, Texas Department of Insurance, at jean.sustaita@tdi.state.tx.us (by e-mail); or to 333 Guadalupe, Hobby Tower 3, Room 550, Austin, Texas (by hand delivery); or to P O. Box 149104, Austin, Texas 78714-9104 (by mail)
  - (b) All interested parties, including those listed on the Applicant's Certificate of Service.
3. The written objection must specifically list all reasons for objection with supporting references to and discussion of statutory and case authorities. Reasons not stated in writing will not be considered orally
4. If a matter is set for submission, an objecting party shall expeditiously coordinate with Applicant's counsel and the master's docket clerk [(512) 463-6450] to obtain an oral hearing, unless the Master determines that an oral hearing is not necessary. The objecting party shall serve a Notice of Oral Hearing on applicant's counsel and all interested parties, including those listed on the Applicant's Certificate of Service.

5. Failure to file timely a written objection before the Special Master constitutes a waiver of the right to object to the Special Master's recommendation to the District Court

**ORDER APPROVING AMENDED FINAL REPORT  
AND APPLICATION TO DISTRIBUTE ASSETS**

On this day, the Court heard and considered the Amended Final Report and Application to Distribute Assets (the "Amended Final Report and Application") filed by Harry L. Sivley, the Special Deputy Receiver ("SDR") under contract to Mike Geeslin, Receiver of Comprehensive Health Services of Texas, Inc., d/b/a Wellchoice, in Receivership, in this Cause

The Court finds that (i) notice has been served as required by law; (ii) the Application meets all requirements of law; (iii) this Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of the Application pursuant to Tex. Insurance Code (the "Code") Chapter 443; (iv) the Amended Order of Reference to Master (the "Order of Reference") entered by this Court on November 3, 2005, provides that certain applications filed pursuant to Code Chapter 443 are referred to the Special Master appointed in the proceeding; (v) the Application was submitted to the Special Master in accordance with the Order of Reference; (vi) notice of the Application was provided in accordance with Code §443.007(d), and the Order of Reference, and no objections to the Application have been filed; (vii) the Special Master has issued a recommendation that the Application be granted pursuant to Tex. R. Civ. P. 171; and (viii) the recommendation of the Special Master should be confirmed and the Application should be Granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, that the Amended Final Report filed by the SDR be, and hereby is, accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, that all previously filed Statements of Expenses have been duly approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, that the Application to Distribute Assets is GRANTED in all respects, and the SDR be, and hereby is, is authorized as follows:

- A to reserve \$26,382 from the distribution of the Estate to be used to pay administrative costs to be incurred until closing of the Receivership;
- B to timely file the federal income tax return for 2009, and any documents after the filing of the Final Accounting;
- C to distribute the cash assets of the estate as proposed herein;
- D to deem as unclaimed any payment to a claimant whose distribution is returned as undeliverable;
- E to maintain the Receivership accounts for up to ninety (90) days or less after the entry of this Order, and to deliver all unclaimed funds to the Commissioner;
- F to transfer any residual funds accumulated after the distribution of assets to the Commissioner for deposit in an account pursuant to Code §443 304(c);
- G to destroy all non-essential Receivership records;
- H to deliver all remaining records to the Commissioner, to maintain, transfer, or dispose of any other records, at his discretion;
- I to assign to the Commissioner any and all presently unknown cash and non-cash assets of the Receivership in the event that any such assets should be discovered in the future;
- J to submit to the Court a final itemized and verified expense report;
- K to submit to the Court after the distribution is made, a Final Accounting and an order releasing and discharging the SDR and the Receiver; and

L to take such other actions as may be necessary or proper to effectuate this Order.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that all previously filed Statements of Expenses have been duly approved.

- K to submit to the Court after the distribution is made, a Final Accounting and an order releasing and discharging the SDR and the Receiver; and



TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

COMES NOW Harry L. Sivley, Special Deputy Receiver (the "SDR") under contract to Mike Geeslin, Commissioner of Insurance (the "Commissioner"), as Receiver of Comprehensive Health Services of Texas, Inc., d/b/a Wellchoice (the "Receiver" and the "Receivership"), and files this Final Accounting And Application To Terminate Receivership And Discharge Receiver And Special Deputy Receiver (the "Final Accounting and Application"), and in support thereof would respectfully show the Court as follows:

**I.  
AUTHORITY**

1 The SDR is authorized to file this Final Accounting and Application pursuant to Texas Insurance Code §443.352. The subject matter of this Final Accounting and Application has been referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding in accordance with the Amended Order of Reference to Master entered on November 3, 2005.

**II.  
BACKGROUND**

2 On August 31, 2009, this Court approved an *Order Approving Amended Final Report and Application to Make Final Distribution* (the "Distribution Order"). The Distribution Order required the SDR to make a distribution of assets, and file a Final Accounting thereof. The SDR has completed the distribution of assets and hereby submits its Final Accounting. The SDR requests that the Court terminate this Receivership, and discharge the Receiver and SDR.

**III.  
EXPENSES**

3. In its Final Report, the SDR estimated the closing expense to be \$26,382.00. In accordance with the Distribution Order, the SDR withheld the estimated closing expenses and distributed the remainder of the funds to the claimants of the estate, as directed in the Distribution Order. The actual closing expenses from July 2009 through the filing of this Final Accounting are \$20,098.37, as reflected in the Final Statement of Expenses, attached as **Exhibit A**, and submitted for approval by the Court pursuant to Texas Insurance Code §443.015(d).

**IV.  
DISTRIBUTION**

4. In accordance with the Order Approving Final Report and Application to Make Final Distribution, the SDR made distribution payments in the months July 2009 through February 2010. An accounting of the final distributions made is attached as **Exhibit B**.

**V.  
TRANSFER OF UNCLAIMED AND RESIDUAL FUNDS**

5. The Distribution Order authorized the SDR to treat as unclaimed any distribution to a claimant whose distribution payment was undeliverable and/or otherwise unpaid. The distribution payments that were undeliverable and/or otherwise unpaid (after conduct of an internet address search), in the total amount of \$294,992.73, are particularly reflected on **Exhibit C**, attached hereto. Accordingly, the SDR has delivered these unclaimed funds to the Commissioner pursuant to Texas Insurance Code §443.304(a), and the funds have been placed in a segregated account. The Commissioner's staff will make further efforts to locate the owners of these funds, and attempt to remit these funds to those owners that are found.

6. The Distribution Order authorized the SDR to pay any residual funds to the Commissioner to be utilized to help defray costs incurred after the distribution. After payment of the distribution payments and final expenses, the residual funds total \$7,092.13. This amount has been transferred to the Commissioner in accordance with the Distribution Order.

**VI.  
RECORDS**

7. The Distribution Order authorized the SDR to destroy certain records of the Receivership that were no longer required for the administration of the Receivership. The remaining records of the Receivership have been inventoried by the SDR and transferred to the Commissioner. The SDR requests that the Commissioner have authority to dispose of any or all records transferred to him at his discretion

**VII.  
FEDERAL INCOME TAX RETURNS**

8. The Distribution Order authorized the SDR to timely file the federal income tax returns for the years 2009 and 2010 and any other documents necessary to file the returns. The SDR has filed federal income tax returns for 2009. Federal incomes taxes in the amount of \$286.00 were paid for 2009. There are no federal income taxes owed by the Receivership for 2010. The final tax return for 2010 will be filed after the filing of this Application.

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

9. Attached hereto as **Exhibits D & E**, respectively, are the final Statement of Net Assets and Statement of Liabilities & Equity, and Sources And Uses Of Cash for the Receivership

**IX.  
CHARTER AND LICENSE**

10. The SDR requests this Court to order that the corporate charter of Comprehensive Health Services of Texas, Inc., d/b/a Wellchoice, be deemed cancelled without further action pursuant to Tex. Ins Code Ann §443 153(e).

**X.  
ASSIGNMENT**

11. The Distribution Order authorized the SDR to assign unknown assets of the Receivership to the Commissioner. The SDR completed the transfer of assets to be assigned. A copy of the executed assignment to the Commissioner is attached hereto as **Exhibit F**.

**XI.  
DISCHARGE OF RECEIVER AND SDR**

12. Having resolved all issues remaining in the estate, and because all property justifying the expense of collection and distribution has been collected and distributed, the SDR requests that this Court grant an Order:

- A discharging the Commissioner as Receiver and releasing him from any and all bonds in connection with this proceeding;
- B. discharging Harry L. Sivley as the SDR, and releasing him from any and all bonds in connection with this proceeding; and
- C. terminating this Receivership


WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the SDR respectfully prays that this Court enter an order:
