Notice of Workers' Compensation Filing
National Council on Compensation Insurance *Item E-1406*

Description:

- The National Council on Compensation Insurance (NCCI) filed *Item E-1406* — *Revisions to the ERM-14 Form and Rule 3-A in the Experience Rating Plan Manual* on August 22, 2019. The ERM-14 is an NCCI form that insurers use to report changes in ownership information. *Item E-1406* proposes to revise the ERM-14 form by shortening it and clarifying wording so it is easier to understand. The reference to the form in Rule 3-A is also being updated.

Requested Effective Date:

- The filing proposes that the changes would apply to new and renewal workers' compensation policies effective on and after February 1, 2020.

Affected NCCI Manuals:

- *Experience Rating Plan Manual for Workers Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance.*
