

Informal Working Draft and Request for Informal Comments on Filing Exemptions Rule

Texas Administrative Code, Title 28, Chapter 5, Subchapter F, Division 3, §5.5201

Posting date: June 2, 2023

Comments due: July 3, 2023

The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) has prepared an informal working draft of a rule implementing [Senate Bill 1367](#), 87th Legislature, 2021, which eliminated rate and rule filing requirements for numerous commercial lines of insurance. SB 1367 authorizes the commissioner to exempt additional commercial lines, in order to promote enhanced competition or more effectively use TDI resources that might otherwise be used to review filings.

TDI staff has prepared draft rule text listing additional commercial lines of property and casualty insurance that would be exempt from the rate and form filing requirements of Insurance Code Chapter 2251, [Subchapter C](#), and Chapter 2301, [Subchapter A](#). If adopted, it will be in a new division and section in Chapter 5, [Subchapter F](#), of Title 28 of the Texas Administrative Code. The draft also includes clarifying language about the scope of some of the exempted lines.

TDI invites your input. This is an informal posting intended to gather comments from stakeholders and the general public; it is not a formal publication for rulemaking.
