#### **Filing Memorandum**

### Purpose

This item revises the treatment for certain classifications in NCCI's **Basic Manual for Workers Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance** for Texas (**Basic Manual** for Texas).

## Background

The workers compensation classification system groups employers with similar operations by classification so that loss costs and rates may be calculated to reflect overall employee exposure to injury.

#### Reassignment of Texas-specific classifications to same multistate code

NCCI began the effort to streamline the classification approach in Texas with the implementation of Item 01-TX-2022— Revisions to Basic Manual for Texas for Classifications and Table of Classifications by Hazard Group, effective July 1, 2023. The overall expansion of the classification code system in Texas will provide further classification uniformity, both in Texas and from a multistate level perspective, to better align exposure to pricing within an individual class code.

NCCI is continuing to use a phased filing approach in determining where it is appropriate to align Texas classifications with the multistate classification approach. This item includes 15 Texas classifications for revisions, as applicable to the classification, to

- eliminate Texas-specific classification phraseologies
- eliminate Texas-specific classification phraseologies and reassign to multistate classification phraseologies, or
- establish specific multistate phraseologies for use in Texas.

#### Removing references to nonapplicable Code 9521

Code 3064 and Code 9554 currently refer to Code 9521. Because Code 9521 is not applicable in Texas, the references to it must be removed for Texas. Refer to the Proposal section for the code phraseology details.

#### Revising the hazard group in Texas for Code 2361

In both Item B-1444—NCCI's Basic Manual for Workers Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance and Item B-1446—Revisions to NCCI's Basic Manual, Residual Market Manual, and Forms Manual, Code 2361 was inadvertently filed and approved based on multistate information, showing Hazard Group D. The correct hazard group in Texas for Code 2361 is Hazard Group C.

### **Removing references to nonapplicable Code 9521**

NCCI proposes to remove all references to Code 9521 in Code 3064 and Code 9554 in Texas because Code 9521 does not apply in Texas. The classifications and associated phraseologies needing revision include

- Code 3064:
  - Sign Manufacturing—Metal

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- Sign Manufacturing-Neon
- Sign Manufacturing—Silk Screen Printing—Metal
- Code 9554: Sign Installation, Maintenance, Repair, Removal, or Replacement NOC—Away From Shop & Drivers

## Revising the hazard group in Texas for Code 2361

NCCI proposes to revise the hazard group for Code 2361 to show the correct Texas-specific Hazard Group C.

#### Impact

#### Reassignment of Texas-specific classifications to same multistate code

For the Texas classifications that will be eliminated and reassigned to the same multistate code, it is expected that there should be no movement of payroll because the multistate phraseology is similar to the Texas phraseology. There is expected to be no impact to overall statewide premium as a result of these changes.

#### Removing references to nonapplicable Code 9521

Removing the references to Code 9521 from the phraseology notes of Code 3064 and Code 9554 should have no premium impact because Code 9521 does not apply in Texas.

#### Revising the hazard group in Texas for Code 2361

The correction from Hazard Group D to Hazard Group C for Code 2361 should have no premium impact because the loss costs and experience rating values are based on the correct Hazard Group C. However, if an employer's final premium was previously calculated using Hazard Group D, there may be a premium change. There is expected to be no impact to overall statewide premium as a result of this change.
