The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) is seeking written input on updates to the rules for the Texas All-Payor Claims Database (APCD). If adopted, the informal working draft would update the Texas APCD Common Data Layout (CDL), make technical clarifications, require more timely data submissions from carriers after their claim adjudication is complete, and implement changes to the advisory committee consistent with House Bill 3414, 88th Legislature, 2023.

TDI invites your input on the informal working draft and requests that carriers provide any relevant information, particularly estimates on the cost to implement these changes. This is an informal posting intended to gather comments from stakeholders and the general public; it is not a formal publication for rulemaking.
