**Description:**

- The filing revises classifications related to bakery and restaurant operations, including mobile food vendors.
- NCCI proposes that the changes be effective for new and renewal workers' compensation policies issued on or after 12:01 a.m. on July 1, 2027.
- Per Commissioner's Order No. 3142, dated March 21, 2014, the commissioner may issue an order approving the filing, approving the filing with changes, or rejecting the filing.
