

Request for Input on Concepts for the Fire Sprinkler Installation and Maintenance Rules

The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) and the State Fire Marshal's Office (SFMO) have prepared a request for input on concepts regarding possible revisions to the Fire Sprinkler Rules, 28 TAC §§34.701–34.725.

Potential revisions include:

- Providing a definition for "supervision";
- Providing a definition for "direct supervision";
- Clarifying what license is required for the various project types (i.e., RME-G or RME-I); and
- Clarifying what level of supervision is required at the different stages of a project.

TDI and SFMO invite your input on these ideas. Questions to consider in giving input are included in the [concepts for input](#) document. This is an informal posting intended to gather comments from stakeholders and the general public. This is *not* a formal publication for rulemaking.
