Subject: Adoption: Repeal 28 TAC §43.15 Regarding Sanctions and §43.20 Regarding Required Information to Insureds

On November 12, 2013 the Commissioner of Workers' Compensation Rod Bordelon adopted the repeal of 28 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §43.15 and §43.20 regarding sanctions against insurance carriers for failure to file notice with the Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (TDI-DWC) and required information to insureds. The adoption was filed with the Office of the Secretary of State on November 18, 2013. The adoption will be published in the November 29, 2013 issue of the *Texas Register* and may be viewed at that time on the Secretary of State website at <http://www.sos.state.tx.us/texreg/index.shtml>. Following a rule review, the TDI-DWC determined the repeal of 28 TAC §43.15 and §43.20 is necessary because the sections are unnecessary and outdated.

These sections are repealed effective December 8, 2013.
