Subject: Adoption: Repeal 28 TAC Chapter 89 Regarding the Crime Victims Compensation Act

On November 21, 2013, the Commissioner of Workers' Compensation Rod Bordelon adopted the repeal of 28 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 89, regarding the Crime Victims Compensation Act. The adoption was filed with the Office of the Secretary of State on November 22, 2013. The adoption will be published in the December 6, 2013 issue of the *Texas Register* and may be viewed at that time on the Secretary of State website at <http://www.sos.state.tx.us/texreg/index.shtml>. The purpose of these adopted rules is to repeal obsolete rules that have been superseded by subsequent legislation.

The adopted repeal is effective 20 days after it publishes in the Texas Register.
