§102.12. Electronic Transmission of Information.

(a) In Part 2 of this title (Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation), for any rule that requires submission of information to or from the division, electronic transmission of that information satisfies the requirement.

(b) Under Labor Code §401.024, electronic transmission in accordance with this rule is sufficient even where another provision of Labor Code Title 5, Subtitle A, specifies a different form, manner, or procedure for the transmission of the information.

(c) Consistent with §§102.4 and 102.5 of this chapter (concerning communications), electronic transmission is defined as the transmission of information by fax, electronic mail, electronic data interchange (EDI), or any similar method. It does not include telephonic communication.

(d) The division may send the information a different way if the division does not have a way to send it to the person electronically, or if the person requests nonelectronic transmission.
