TRANSPORTATION INCIDENTS
ARE THE NUMBER **ONE** CAUSE OF FATAL
WORK-RELATED INJURIES IN TEXAS.

2018 TEXAS STATISTICS

-  46% of all fatal work injuries were caused by transportation incidents.
-  51% of the work-related transportation fatalities involved occupations other than motor vehicle operators.
-  36% of all people who died in vehicles in Texas were not wearing restraints.

Proper maintenance

 **THE ENVIRONMENT**
Conditions outside the vehicle
