1, 2	No	Provide an impact protective system when installing the product in areas that require windborne debris protection.

Installation:

System 1: The wood wall framing members must be minimum Spruce-Pine-Fir dimension lumber. The window must be secured to the wood wall framing using the frame of the window with minimum No. 10 x 2-1/2" screws. Along each side jamb, the fasteners are spaced approximately 6" and 23" from each corner and one at the midpoint. Along the head and the sill, locate the fasteners approximately 6" from each corner and one at the midpoint. Fasteners must be long enough to penetrate a minimum of 1-1/2" into the wall framing.

System 2: The wood wall framing members must be minimum Spruce-Pine-Fir dimension lumber. The window must be secured to the wood wall framing using the frame of the window with minimum No. 10 x 2-1/2" screws. Along each side jamb, the fasteners are spaced approximately 6" from each corner and 16" on center. Along the head and the sill, locate one fastener at the midpoint of each window. Each mullion is secured to the head and the sill with an aluminum mullion clip (3.50" x 2.50" x 0.125"). The clip is secured to the wall framing with two No. 10 x 2-1/2" screws. The clip slides into the vertical mullions and is not secured with fasteners. The fasteners must be long enough to penetrate a minimum of 1-1/2" into the wall framing members.

Note: Keep the manufacturer's installation instructions available on the job site during installation. Use corrosion resistant fasteners as specified in the IRC, IBC, and the Texas Revisions.
