General remarks and official action taken:

This is a consent order with Highland Risk Services, LLC. Highland Risk Services, LLC, failed to timely file surplus lines policies and related documents. Highland Risk Services, LLC, has agreed to pay an \$2,275 administrative penalty for these violations.

Waiver

Highland Risk Services, LLC, acknowledges that the Texas Insurance Code and other applicable law provide certain rights. Highland Risk Services, LLC, waives all of these rights, and any other applicable procedural rights, in consideration of the entry of this consent order.

Findings of Fact

1. Highland Risk Services, LLC, firm identification number 112611, holds a surplus lines license issued by the Texas Department of Insurance.

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- 3. Pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code § 981.105(a), a surplus lines insurance agent must file with the Surplus Lines Stamping Office of Texas either:
 - a. a copy of the policy issued or
 - b. if the policy has not yet been issued, a copy of the certificate, cover note, or other confirmation of insurance delivered to the insured.

This information is due not later than the 60th day after the later of the effective date or the issue date of new or renewal surplus lines insurance.

- 4. In 2019, Highland Risk Services, LLC filed surplus lines policies late.
- 5. In March 2020, TDI assessed fees against Highland Risk Services, LLC, because the late-filed surplus lines policies met at least one of the conditions in TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(d-e).
- 6. Highland Risk Services, LLC, did not timely pay the fees assessed pursuant to Tex. INS. CODE § 981.105(c-e).
- 7. The commissioner previously disciplined Highland Risk Services, LLC, for violating Tex. Ins. Code § 981.105(a) in Official Order No. 2020-6246, entered on February 26, 2020.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 84.021-84.044, and 981.105.
- 2. The commissioner of insurance has authority to informally dispose of this matter under Tex. Ins. Code § 82.055, Tex. Gov't Code § 2001.056, and 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.47.
- 3. Highland Risk Services, LLC, has knowingly and voluntarily waived all procedural rights to which it may have been entitled regarding the entry of this order, including, but not limited to, issuance and service of notice of intention to institute disciplinary action, notice of hearing, a public hearing, a proposal for decision, rehearing by the commissioner, and judicial review.
- 4. Highland Risk Services, LLC, violated Tex. Ins. Code § 981.105(a) by failing to timely file new or renewal surplus lines policies and related documents.

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Order

It is ordered that Highland Risk Services, LLC must pay an administrative penalty of \$2,275. The administrative penalty must be paid within 30 days from the date of this order. The administrative penalty must be paid by cashier's check or money order made payable to the "State of Texas."
