General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Lemicher Allen (Respondent) because she engaged in the unauthorized business of insurance, willfully violated an insurance law of this state, misappropriated or converted funds, and engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order directs Respondent to pay an administrative penalty, make restitution to victims, and to cease and desist from engaging in the business of insurance.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

1. On September 18, 2023, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, together with a previously filed Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

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Lemicher Allen

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3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition together to Respondent's last known address, [REDACTED], Fort Worth, Texas 76133. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail to [REDACTED].
4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 84.021-84.044, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4051.051; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing under TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.

Order

It is ordered that Lemicher Allen cease and desist from engaging in the business of insurance and pay an administrative penalty of \$10,000 within 30 days from the date of this order. The administrative penalty must be paid as instructed in the invoice, which the department will send after entry of this order.

It is further ordered that within 90 days from the date of this order, Lemicher Allen must pay restitution in the following amounts to the following individuals as described in

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Enforcement Case No. 26378: \$4,175 to G.L.; \$550 to K.W.; and \$825 to P.H. The restitution must be paid by cashier's check or money order made payable to the named person in the amount specified in this order. Lemicher Allen must provide written proof of payment to the department within 90 days of the date of this order by emailing it to EnforcementReports@tdi.texas.gov.

A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement and/or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.

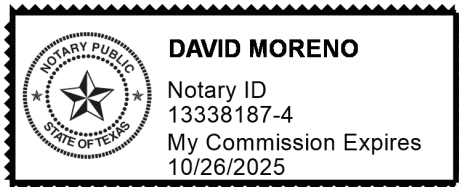

NOTICE OF HEARING

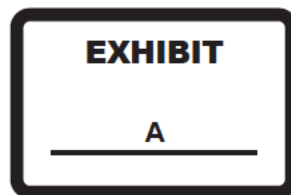
The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) seeks to take disciplinary action against you. This Notice of Hearing and the Original Petition, which is attached and incorporated for all purposes, states the allegations against you and the relief sought by TDI.

A public hearing will be held before an Administrative Law Judge on **Wednesday, January 10, 2024, at 9:15 a.m.** The hearing will take place via videoconference using a videoconference platform controlled by the State Office of Administrative Hearings, unless otherwise ordered to proceed in another manner by the Administrative Law Judge.

The hearing shall be conducted under TEX. GOV'T CODE, ch. 2001 and 1 TEX. ADMIN. CODE, ch. 155. Unless otherwise directed by the Administrative Law Judge, the hearing shall continue from day to day in the offices of the State Office of Administrative Hearings until concluded. You have the right to appear at this hearing and to be represented by an attorney.

Parties that are not represented by an attorney may obtain information regarding contested case hearings on the public website of the State Office of Administrative Hearings at www.soah.texas.gov, or in printed format upon request to SOAH.

YOU MUST FILE A WRITTEN RESPONSE TO THE NOTICE OF HEARING WITH THE STATE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS WITHIN 20 DAYS OF THE DATE THE NOTICE OF HEARING WAS MAILED. FAILURE TO FILE A WRITTEN RESPONSE BY THIS DEADLINE SHALL ENTITLE TDI TO SEEK DISPOSITION BY DEFAULT UNDER 1 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 155.501 AND 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 AND 1.89.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Lemicher Allen. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 84.021-84.044, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4051.051, and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

Licensure

1. Lemicher Allen (Allen) does not hold a license or authorization issued by the Texas Department of Insurance.

Unauthorized Sale of Insurance

2. Between June 5, 2017, and September 14, 2020, Allen sold approximately 943 Progressive Group of Insurance Companies (Progressive) policies. Except for two policies, each was quoted and purchased online.
3. Of the 943 policies sold, 99% were for personal auto policies within Texas.

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Original Petition

Lemicher Allen

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4. Out of the 943 total policies, there were 166 named insureds that had two or more policies. Allen had four policies issued in her name.
5. Of the 943 policies, 905 were cancelled because the initial down payment was returned by the bank, 24 were cancelled due to non-payment, 6 were cancelled due to underwriting reasons, two were canceled at the request of the customer, and two policies were not renewed by the customer.
6. From the 943 policies, Progressive received 1,039 payments. Of those payments, 928 were returned by the bank for insufficient funds, not authorized, payment stopped, no account, account closed, account frozen, or account number invalid. One bank account was used on 660 of the 943 policies.
7. Allen stated, to a Progressive Corporate Examiner, that she thought she was selling insurance through a government program for people with low incomes. Allen claimed to be working for Diana Contreras (Contreras) who paid her \$350 dollars a week, they would meet weekly at a McDonalds and Allen would provide her with all the premium payments she received.
8. Allen stated that she created a Capital One bank account to use for the policies that was supposed to be funded by Contreras through donations from insurance companies. Allen claimed that Contreras told her to use only Progressive because the customer could have an ID card instead of an actual driver's license.
9. Allen provided a phone number for Contreras, however the number belonged to someone else. Additionally, she claimed to have proof of payments to Contreras, however the proof of payments provided shows the money was sent to someone other than Contreras.
10. Allen admitted she was not a licensed agent and agreed to no longer sell Progressive policies.

Conversion of Premium Payments

G.L.

11. G.L. estimated that she paid Allen \$50 a month for approximately four years, she estimated paying Allen \$3,000-\$4,000.

12. G.L. also indicated that she paid Allen \$175 for paper plates that turned out to be invalid.

M.L.

13. M.L. attempted to purchase a policy from Allen but the policy was rescinded because the down payment was returned by the bank.
14. M.L. indicated she received the rescission letter from the insurance company, but that Allen claimed she would take care of the situation.
15. M.L. paid Allen for a policy for at least five months.

K.W.

16. Four policies were initially issued to K.W., however each was rescinded due to the down payment being returned by the bank.
17. The email address used on one of K.W.'s policies was used on 179 other policies sold by Allen.
18. K.W. indicated she had been making payments on a policy since November 2019, but the policy kept cancelling and the agent kept providing new policy numbers.
19. K.W. indicated the agent was Ms. Black, however the name on K.W.'s payment receipts were Allen and emails with policy documentation were linked to Allen.
20. K.W. paid Allen a total of \$550; a \$100 down payment and \$75 a month for 6 months.

P.H.

21. On or about January 2020, P.H. was referred to an insurance person that offered a policy for \$100 down payment and \$75 a month.

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Original Petition

Lemicher Allen

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22. P.H. started paying Allen \$75 a month around January 25, 2020. In November 2020, after suffering a loss, P.H. contacted Progressive regarding her policy but was told it had been rescinded and she had no coverage.
23. P.H. paid Allen approximately \$825; \$75 a month for 11 months.

Recent Criminal Activity

24. On or about August 25, 2022, Allen was indicted for Fraudulent Possession of Identifying Information 10-50 Items (Enhanced) and Possession of a Controlled Substance Less Than One Gram (Enhanced).

Legal Allegations

1. Allen has engaged in acts constituting the business of insurance without a license or other authorization from the department in violation of TEX. INS. CODE §§ 101.102, 4001.101, 4005.053, 4051.051, and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 19.902.
2. Allen has willfully violated an insurance law of this state pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(1).
3. Allen misappropriated, converted to her own use, or illegally withheld money belonging to an insurer or insured in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(4).
4. Allen has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

1. ordering Lemicher Allen to cease and desist from certain activity or conduct;
2. directing Lemicher Allen to pay an administrative penalty under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 84.021–84.022;
3. directing Lemicher Allen to make restitution to victim(s) under TEX. INS. CODE § 82.053; and

4. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.

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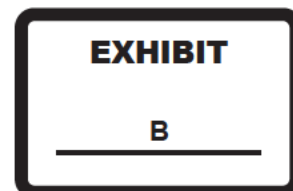

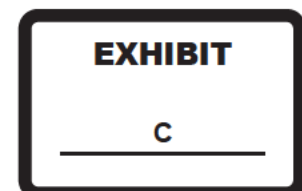
